

# The difference between photo editing and graphic design

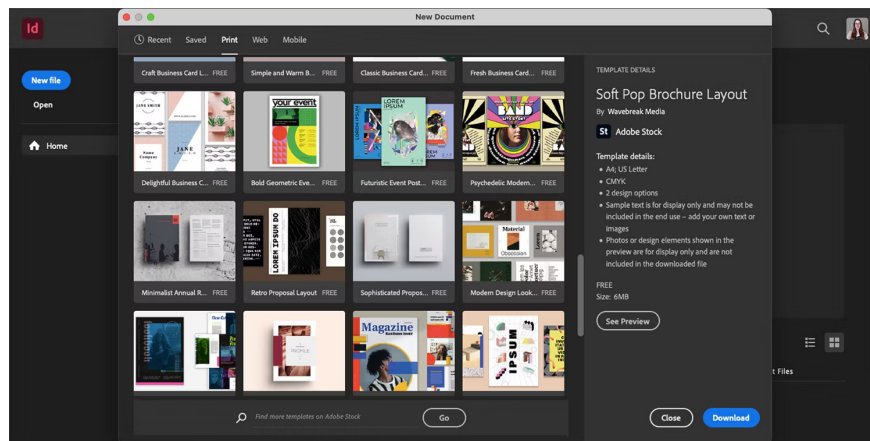
Photo editing and graphic design are often associated with each other, but considering them the same is incorrect.

Graphic design often involves more text than photo editing, and you need to have a good understanding of different fonts. Furthermore, you should know how to design them to work together on

your pages.

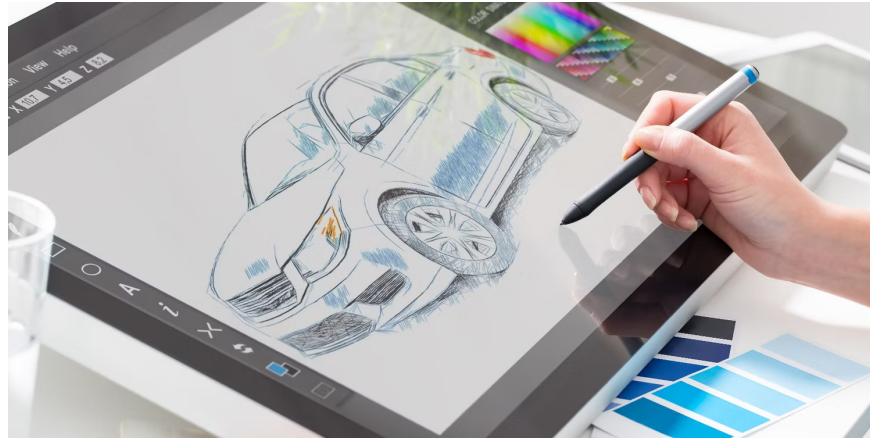
For a professional photographer, photo editing starts with keeping an eye on what you want to capture in the first place.
