

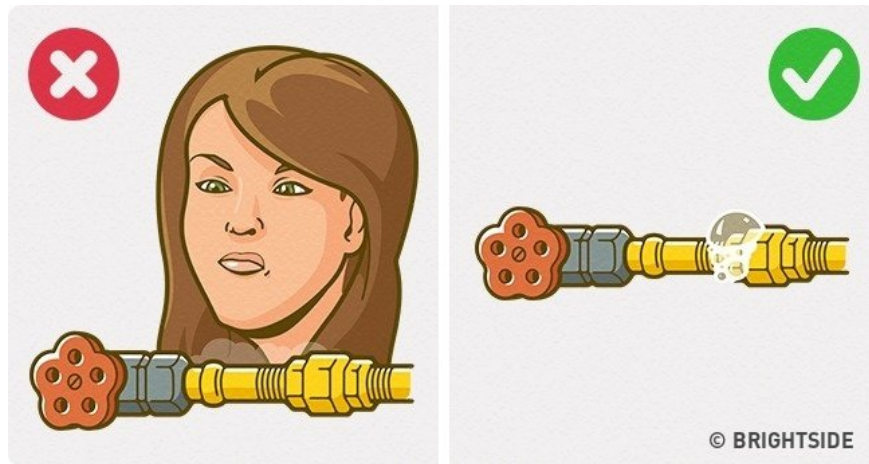

Whether the way to detect gas is leaked



Gas leaks can be fatal, so it is important to inform and repair it as soon as it is discovered. When you smell gas in the air, you should **apply soapy water** to the gas pipeline. If you see a place where there is a big bubble bubble, it will leak. Absolutely do not use the nose to identify the leak.

Clean glass debris



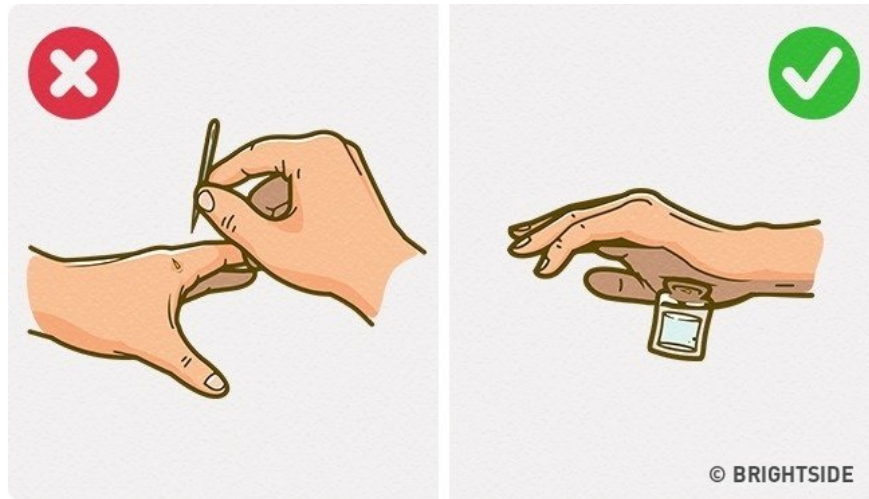
Do not use a broom or vacuum cleaner to clean up debris from a bowl or glass , since this way always leaves small pieces that are difficult to see and dangerous. The best way is to use a wet towel to wipe the debris away and then throw away the towel.

The sand helps the jar and the jar stand firmly



For decorative porcelain pots that are not used for flower arrangement, they are easy to spill because they are both high and empty. To help the vase stand, **just put some sand in it** . However, in the event of a break, you already know how to handle it (*review the tip above*).

Quickly taking the chin, thorns hit the flesh



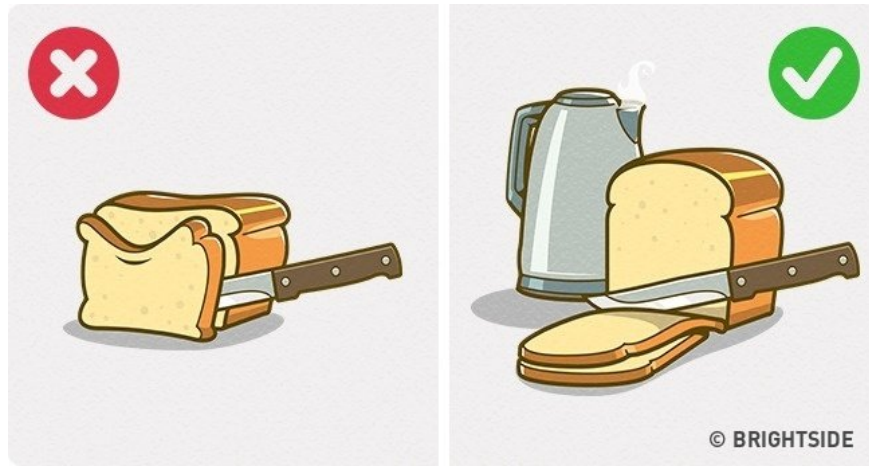
Instead of applying painful methods such as using tweezers to pick up or use needles to hook the chin out, apply the following, extremely gentle method without pain: pour boiling water near a glass jar. small and then put in place with the chin sticking into the mouth of the bottle. The skin of that area will gradually be pulled back and the chin will be sucked out.

Refrigerate alcohol without a refrigerator



Just wrap a towel around the water bottle and place it in the cold water basin. The continuous flow of cool water that flows on the bottle makes any cool liquid in the bottle faster to cool than placing the bottle in the refrigerator.

Cut bread into thin slices



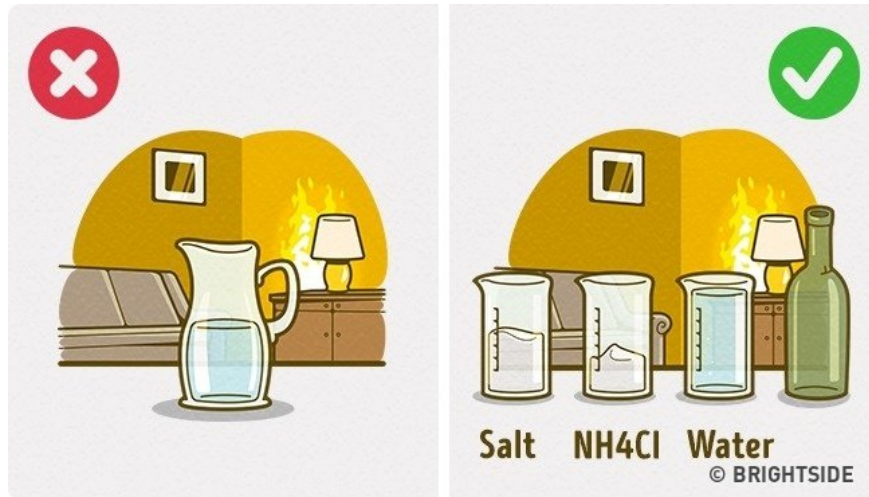
Fresh bread is delicious but there is only one restriction: it is difficult to slice into thin slices because they are dry and very easily crushed under the pressure of the knife. You just need to put bread near a kettle of boiling water. Hot steam will soften the crust, making it easy to cut into thin slices.

Let matches match longer



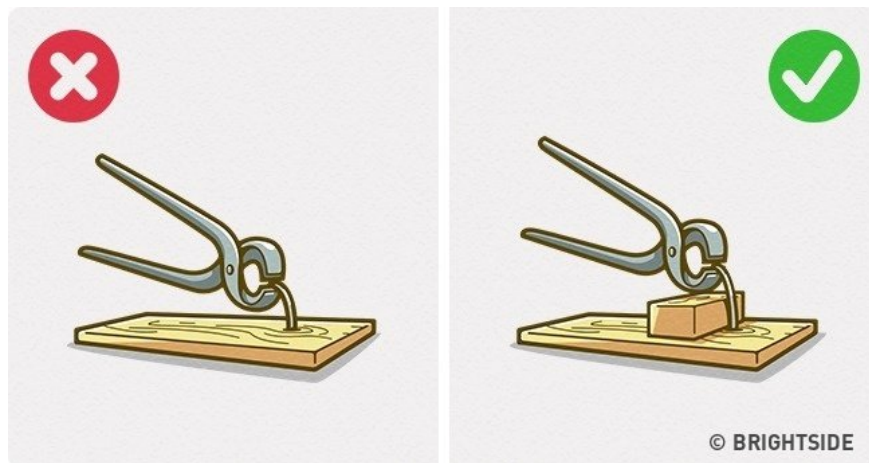
Burning a match is easy, but it is much more difficult to let the flame burn long without the breath or the wind accidentally blowing. So before you match matches, you should use a knife to cut small lines around the matchbox, near the place of contact with the sulfur head, the match will burn longer and be much more difficult to turn off.

Ammonia fire extinguisher



Use only ordinary water sometimes you can't extinguish the fire. You need to prepare a chemical called **Ammonium Chloride** (NH_4Cl) in your home to prevent a fire from occurring. The mixture consists of 700g of salt, 350g of ammonium chloride (salmon ammonia) and about 1.5 liters of water. Then, put it all in a glass bottle and throw it into the fire. The fire will be extinguished immediately.

How to withdraw a long nail



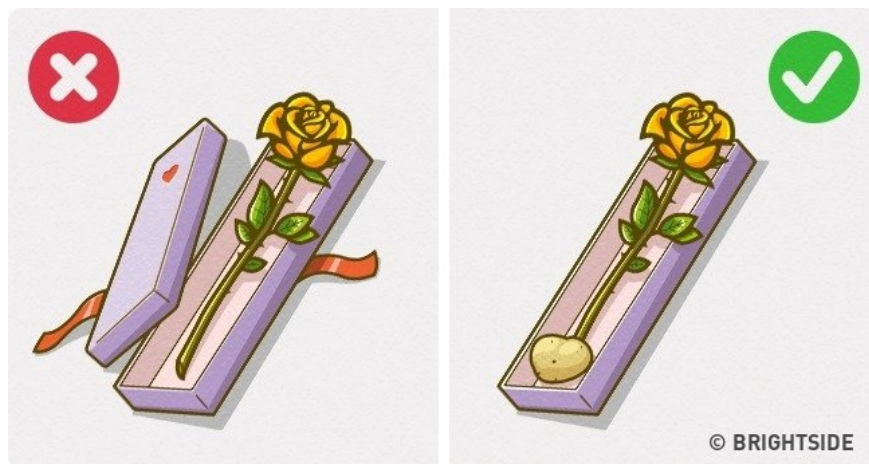
If you only use the pliers / hammer to hold the nail, then pull it out, you will have to be as big as the size of the athlete to be able to do it, especially when the nail is closed to a hardwood board. This task will become much easier if you put down a small wooden pliers / hammer. Then while pulling the nail, you just need to push the pliers / hammer firmly on the log and then pull that nail out very easily.

How to remove two cups that are attracted to each other



Hot to cold , have you heard this principle before? Instead of using force to separate the two cups that are sticking to each other, catch cold water on the inner glass and draw the glass underneath on a hot tub (*or put the glass in the hot water basin*). Thanks to this principle, two cups will be easily separated.

How to preserve fresh flowers without water or light



Very simply, just **plug the flower stalk into a potato** , the flower will always be fresh for a week. After that, you can completely pack and send it to your loved one.

How to identify margarine



If you only use a sniff, you can't tell the difference. To distinguish the two types of butter, **use a piece of paper and apply some butter, then burn that piece of paper** . Butter and milk will give off a very sweet and delicious scent, while margarine has a slightly unpleasant odor and is a bit like the smell of burnt lard.
