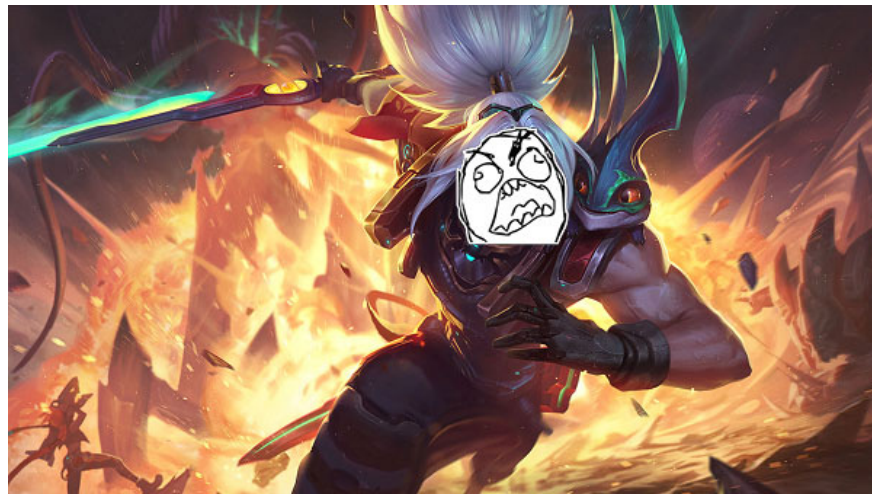


The duo took over Yasuo when he topped the list of champions banned from League

The highest position in Yasuo's League of League's most hated champions has been overtaken by the two most annoying generals in the banned champions rankings in LOL.

Yasuo is a special League of Legends champion that is hated all over the region, especially in Vietnam. The reason is because this is a champion that is very popular with many young people because he can become a great champion that can balance the enemy team or will be extremely wasteful if in the hands of unskilled players. .

Because of his badass, Yasuo has always been the most hated champion of all champions in League, especially in Rank battles.



However, Yasuo's position "most hated champions" is threatened by a name that no one expected. It is Pyke, a general who also causes discomfort no less than Yasuo. Pyke's ban is currently a bit higher than Yasuo's "God", with a ban of up to 50.25%. In addition, there is also another hated general, which is Zed in this ranking.

The reason Pyke overtakes the most hated champion in League is so much because he currently has a great influence in the fight. Although his main task is only in Support.

The strength of the Red Water Assassin is not only in the "holy drag" title because many other generals like Blitzcrank or Nautilus can completely do that. The skill that worries many gamers is that the Ghostly Water Series can surf and paralyze enemies. If you want to run away, just activate the W and then run quickly as if nothing ever happened.



And yet, Pyke also has the advantage of snowballing very early and is really annoying when dealing a huge amount of damage without having to wear equipment like other support champions.

As for Pyke himself, he can gain damage items, and with the passive ability of Pyke's ultimate gold split, Pyke can completely put enormous pressure on the opponent's opponent. In addition, Pyke players only need to do as much damage as possible, not need to do the work that a Support often do such as Plugging Eye or standing embankment at the Gunner.



As for Zed, anyone who has ever encountered him must admit that this general is quite uncomfortable. Especially when he won the road right from the beginning of the game.

The mistake of the confronted Zed players is just because of the impatience trying to fight with him without finding another general capable of controlling Zed. Or have the ability to survive well when the guy cornered damage (even if it's the generals that you do not want to play at all), then surely a few seconds later you will regret when fighting Zed.



In addition, Zed is also the star of all ADCs with the ultimate Mark of Death. Every time he carve a mark on the marksman's head, at least they will be subjected to a large amount of damage and will "scratch" if not dead.

If not with teammates, especially with support players, the ability to counter Zed is completely unavailable. So choose to go with other players to support each other, avoid going individually to be attacked by Zed.

And from here, Yasuo's most hated champion LOL was officially usurped by Pyke and Zed. Although being hated for quite a few reasons, but if you want to climb the safest rank, you should choose these two names if you are not sure which champion to pick.
