

The easiest way to download Google Drive files that are blocked from downloading

Google Drive is a place that helps users store files online effectively, but in some cases, if the ability to download Google Drive files is blocked, it is likely that your account has violated NPH's rules. and limited access to a few key features.

If you are a regular user of **Google Drive** , it is certainly no stranger to you when you encounter the situation of downloading files exceeding the limit on Google Drive, the error of not being able to download files because too many people have downloaded them. But with just a few steps, you can download Google Drive files that are blocked from downloading very simply.

I. Reasons why downloading Google Drive files is blocked from downloading

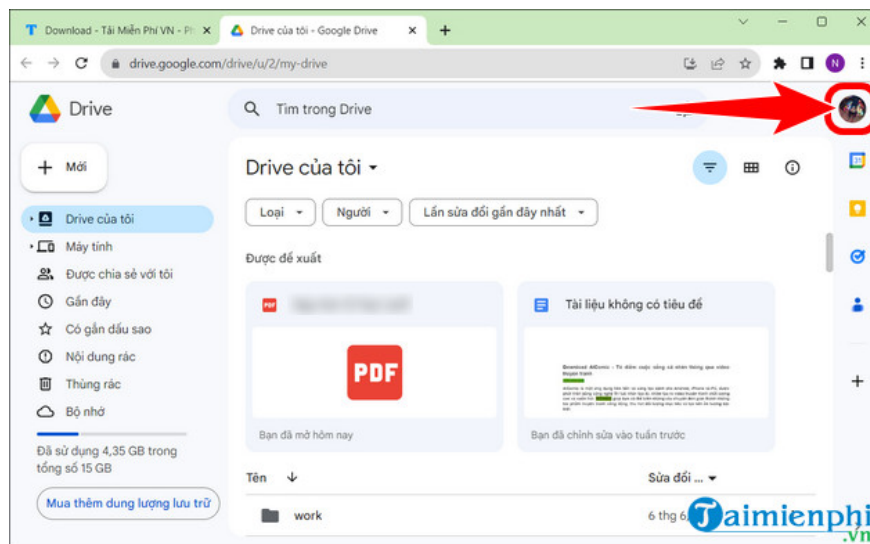
- The author uploading the file to Drive does not want to share it with everyone.
- The number of users accessing the Download exceeds the allowed limit.
- Account violates Google's terms.
- The file contains malicious content and may be infected with a virus.

II. How to download Google Drive files that are blocked from downloading

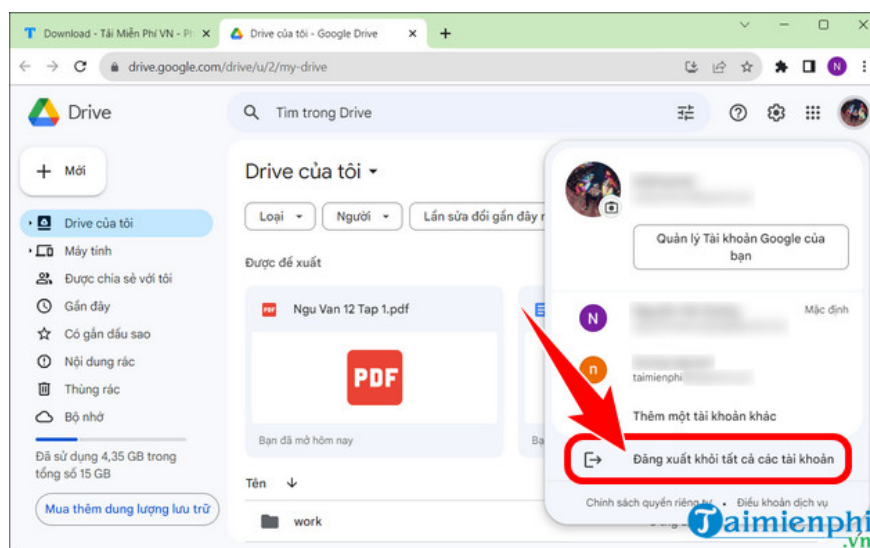
If your account is restricted by the upload author, you can send a request to them or contact them directly to be granted permission to download Google Drive files that are blocked from downloading.

In case your current account violates NPH's terms, causing downloading of Google Drive files to be blocked, you can log out and use a new account to fix this problem.

Step 1: Log in to Google Drive browser on your computer, click **the account icon** in the upper right corner of the screen.

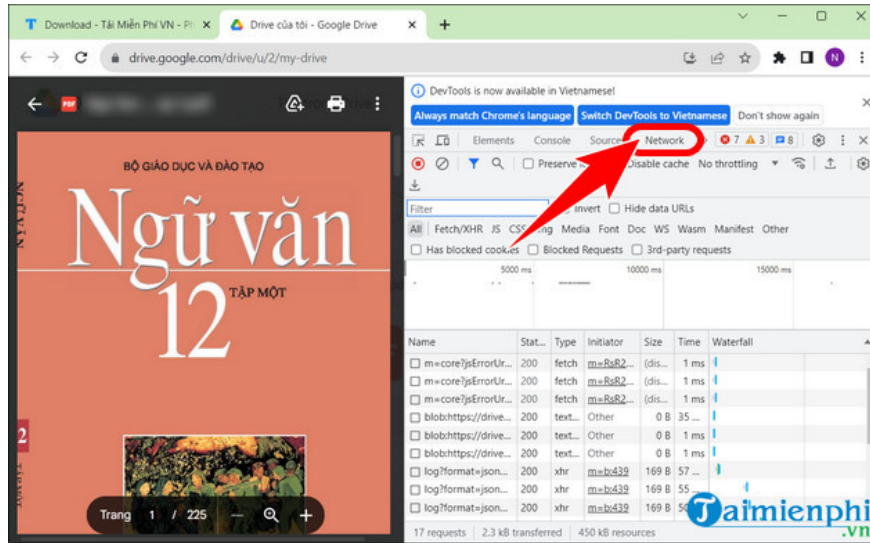


Step 2: Select **Sign out of all accounts** , then **create a new Google account** and sign in.

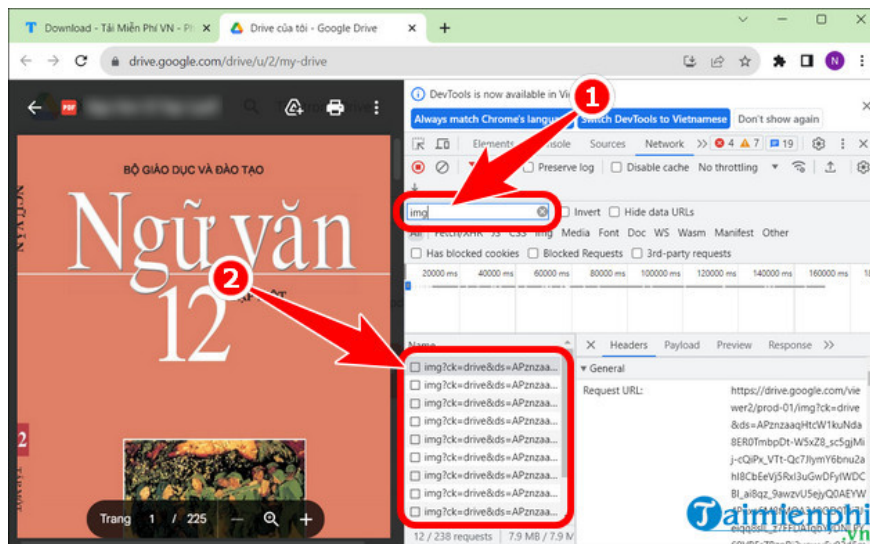


This method only applies to PDF files stored in Drive, files such as .docx cannot be used. You can **convert Word to PDF** if you want to use this tool.

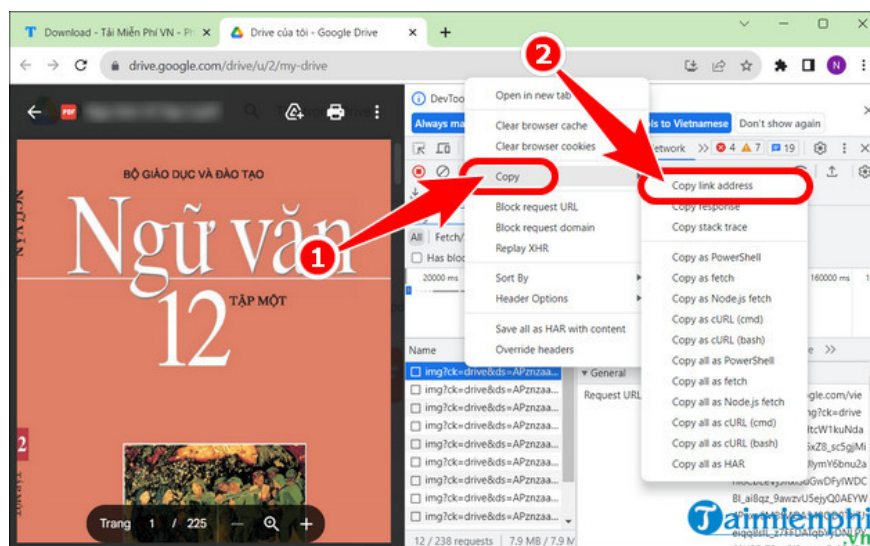
Step 1: Open **the Google Drive file** you want to download, press **F12** on the keyboard => click **Network** .



Step 2: Enter **img** in the **Filter** box => select any **img tag** .

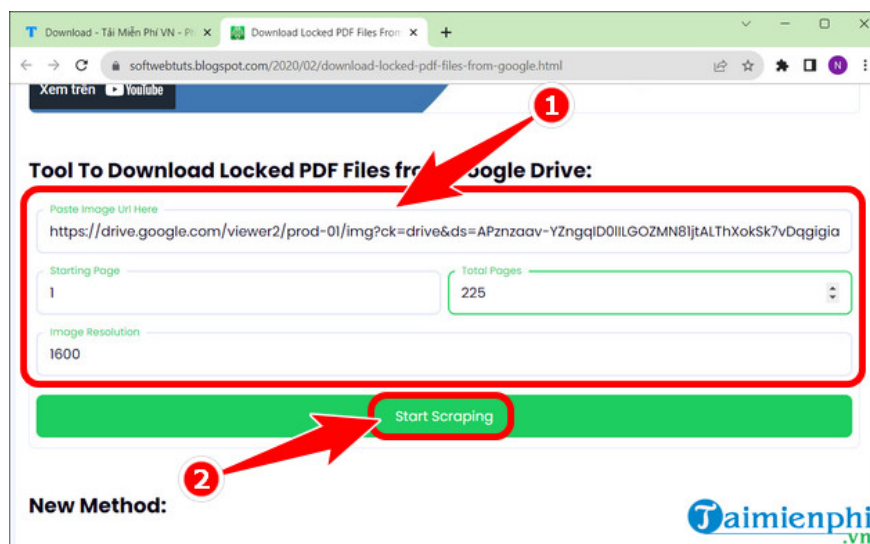


- **Right click** , select **Copy** => press **Copy link address** .

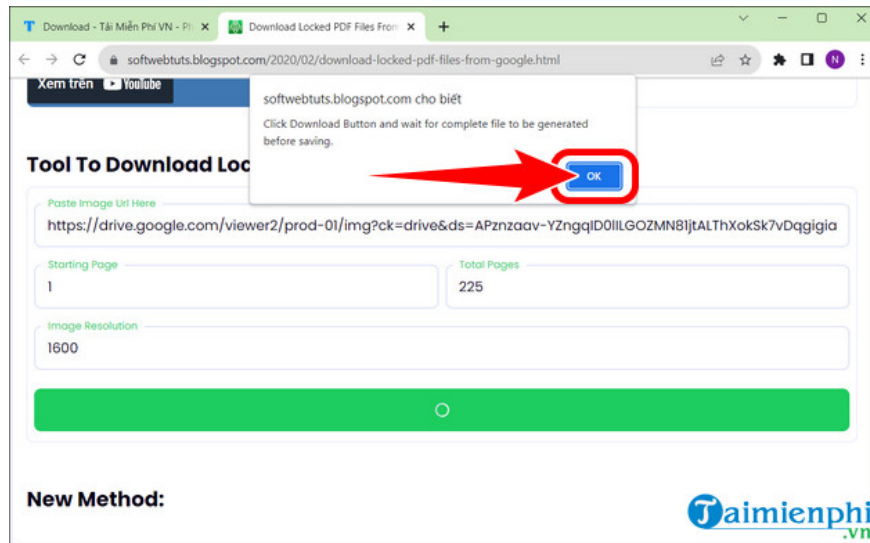


Step 3: Access the Google Drive file download tool **HERE** .

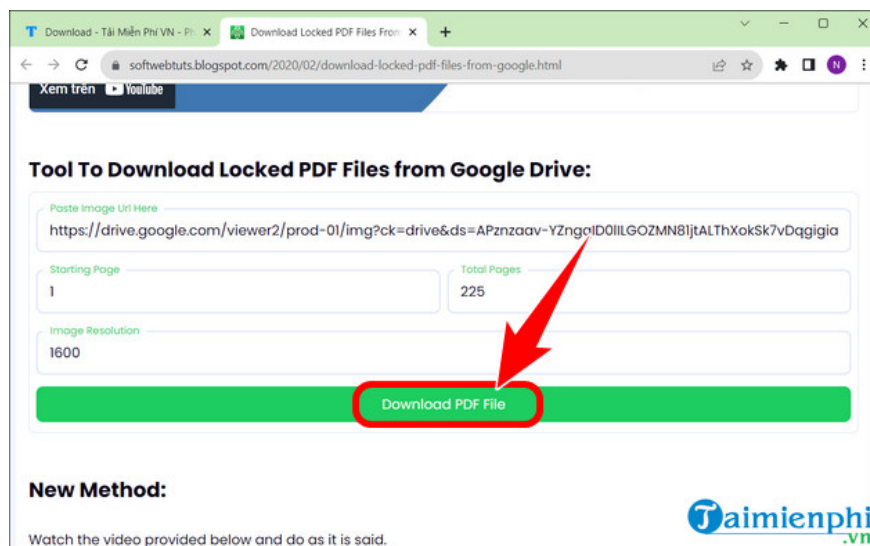
- Paste the copied link into the **Paste Image Url Here** box => enter **Starting Page** and **Total Pages** => adjust **Image Resolution** => **Start Scraping** .



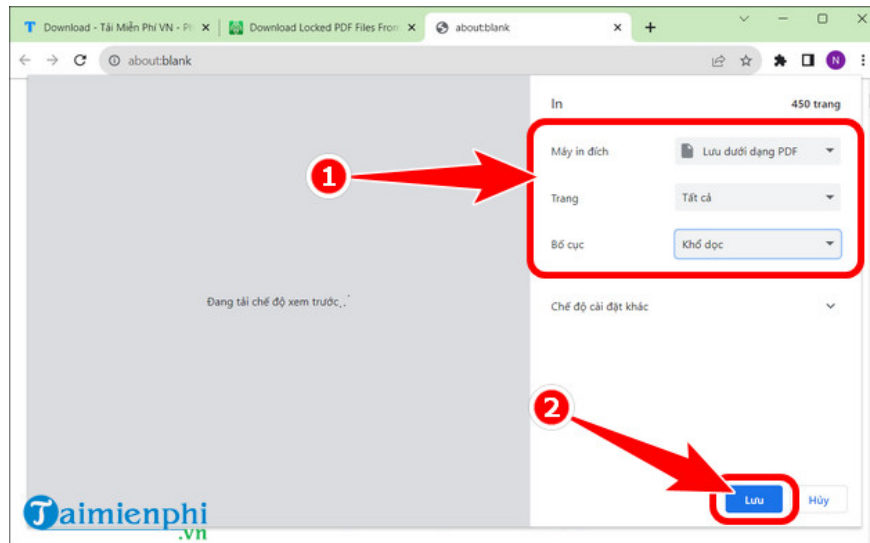
- Wait a few minutes, the system will display a message as shown below, click **OK** .



- Click **Download PDF File** .

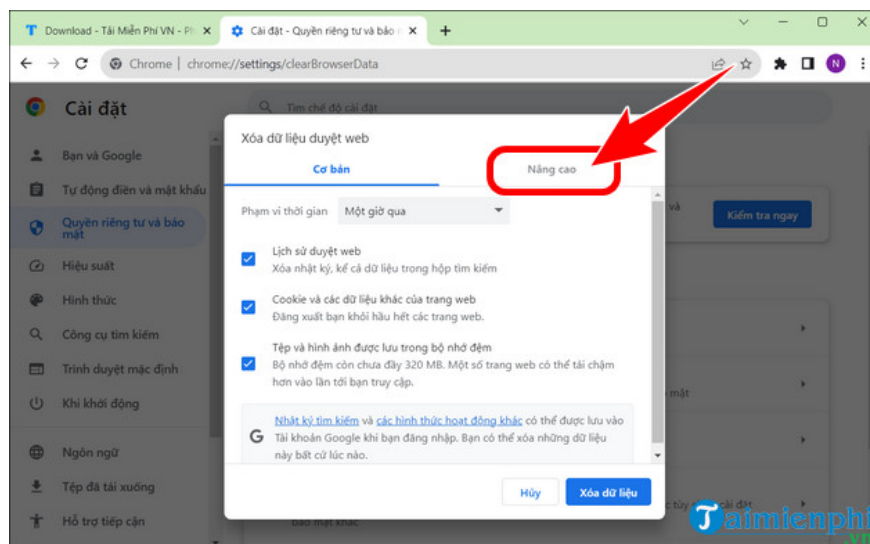


Step 4: Select **Save as PDF** in **Destination printer** => customize **Print Page** , **Layout** => **Save** .

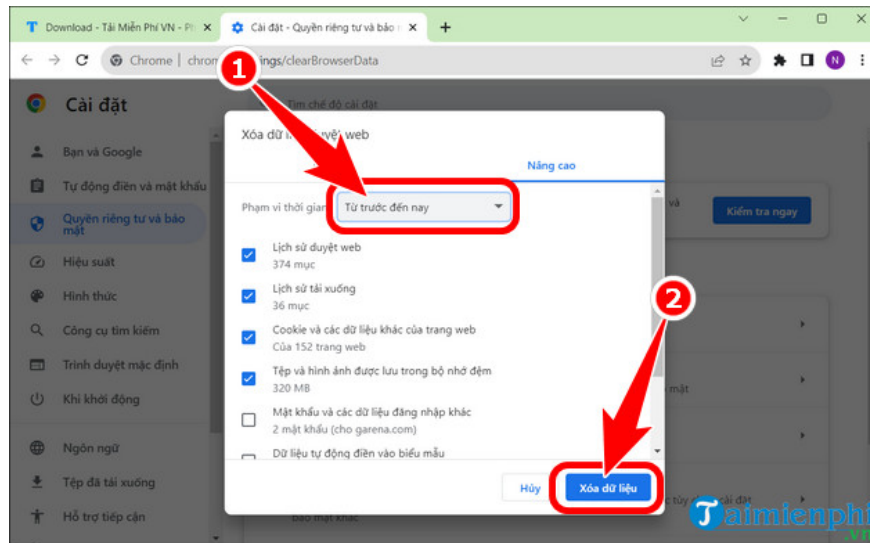


Deleting Cookie data only applies when all three methods above fail.

Step 1: Open Google Chrome browser , press **Ctrl + Shift + Delete** => click **Advanced** .



Step 2: In the **Time range** section , select **From then until now** => **Delete data** . After deleting the data is complete, you just need to reopen File Drive to download the file to your computer.
