3. Giraffes are used as gifts and show strength

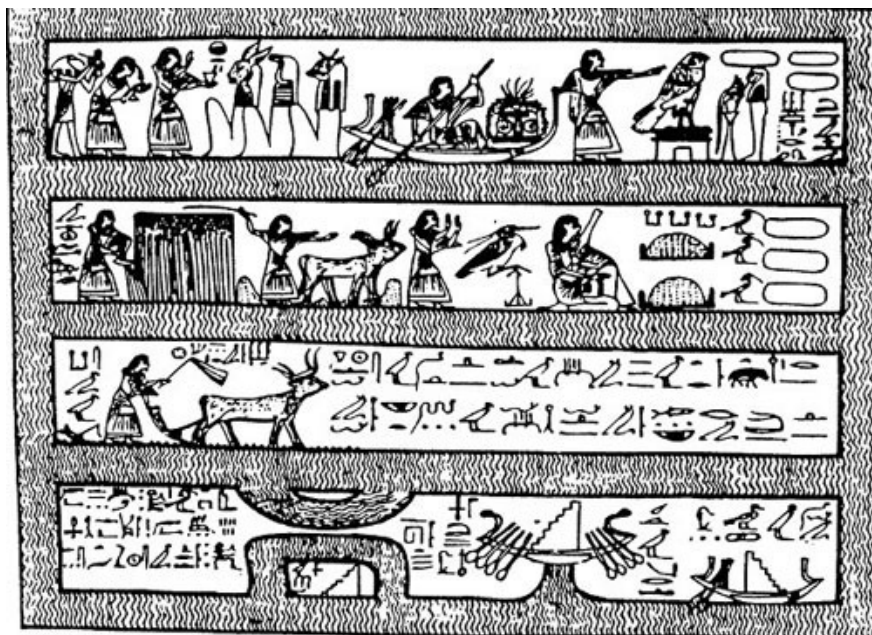


In ancient Egypt, giraffes were considered to be very impressive and luxurious animals. They are used by those in power as gifts and show strength.
