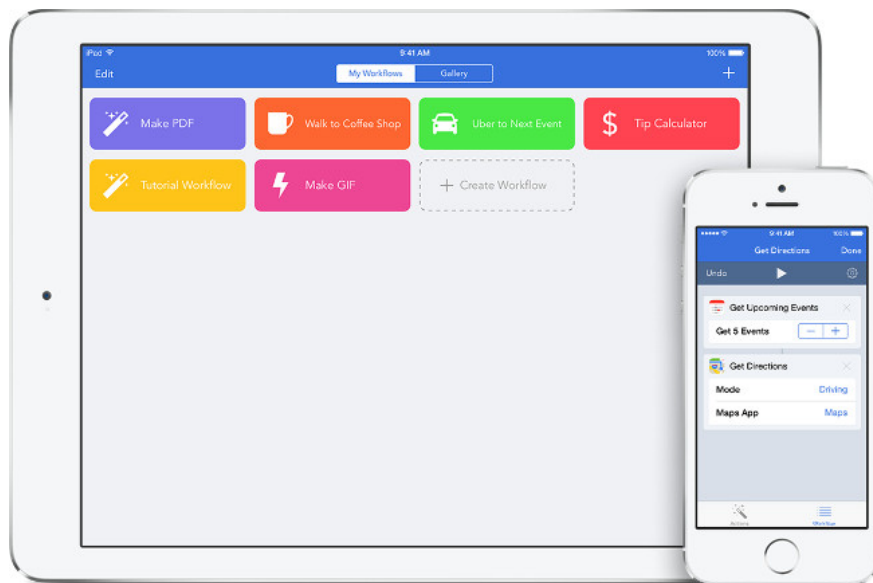


The essentials and basic uses of Apple's new free app

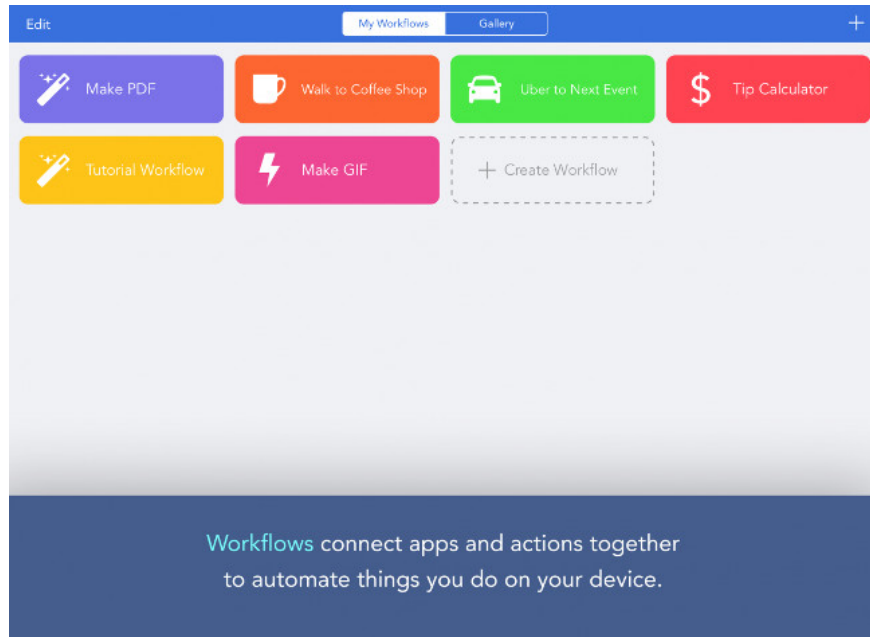
Basically, Workflow will serve as a utility that allows users to simply click on a button to perform that action, instead of a sequence of operations. In addition, Workflow also supports many more convenient features. For example, create GIF images from photos in the gallery, automatically turn web pages into PDF format, delete screen images in the camera roll and more.

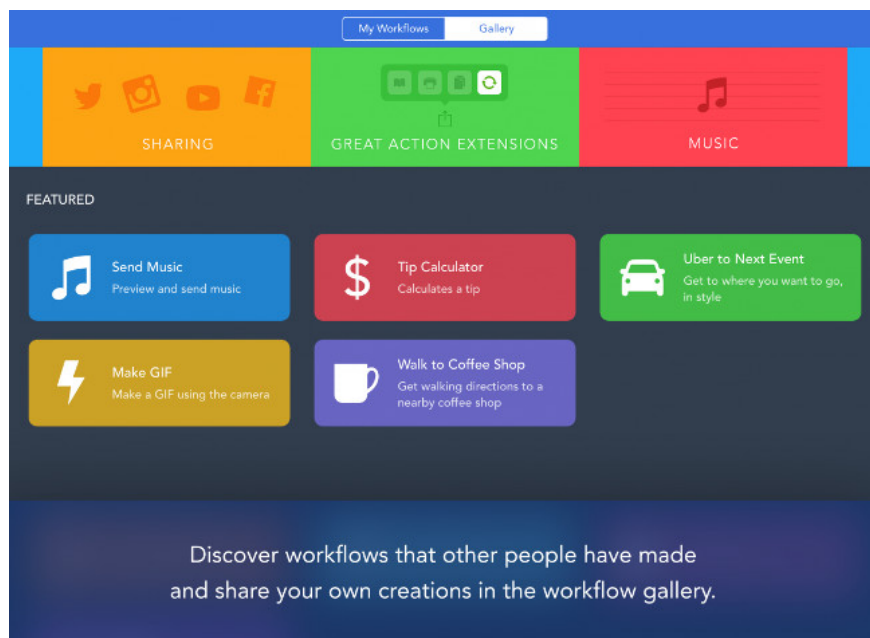

Download the Workflow application to your device

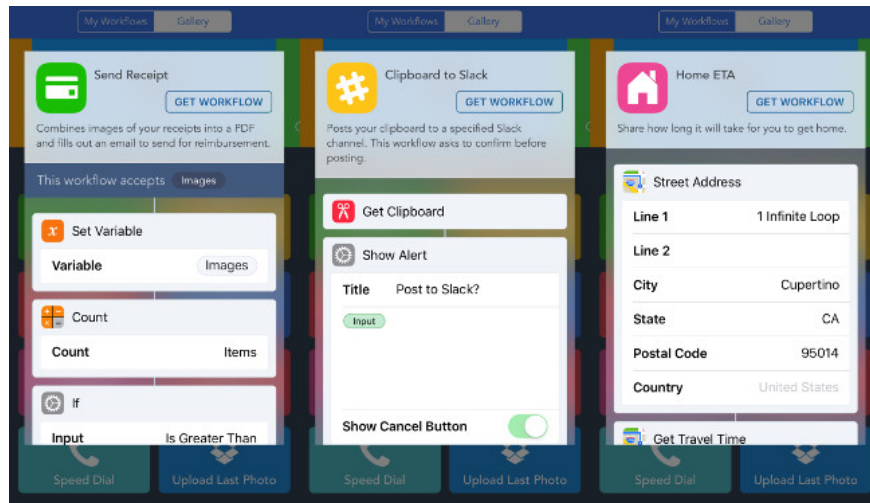
1. Each color bar in the application represents a sequence of operations that perform different tasks, also known as Workflow.



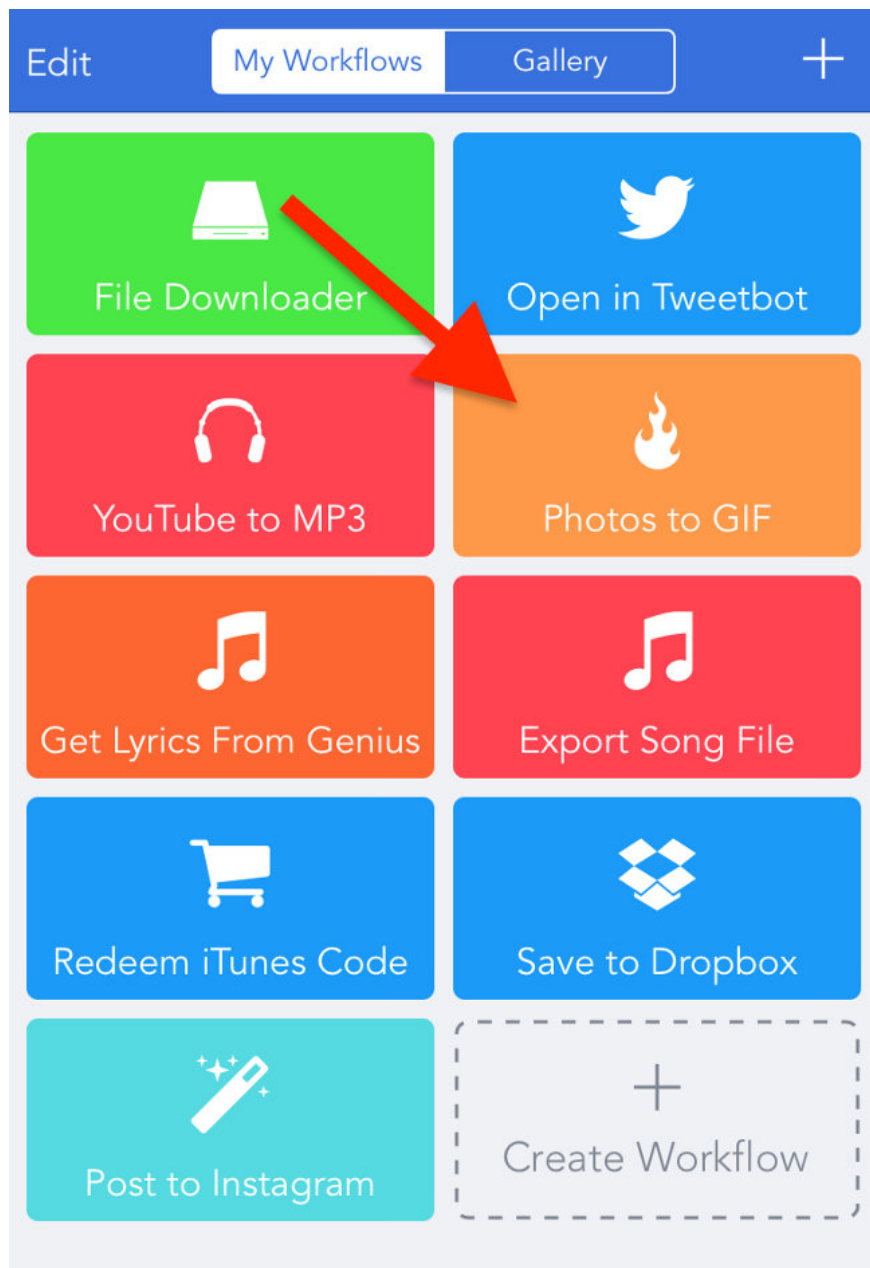
1. The Gallery area will contain other workflows that you can download and apply on your device for free. If you're not good at creating your own series of workflows, this is the most effective and quick way.



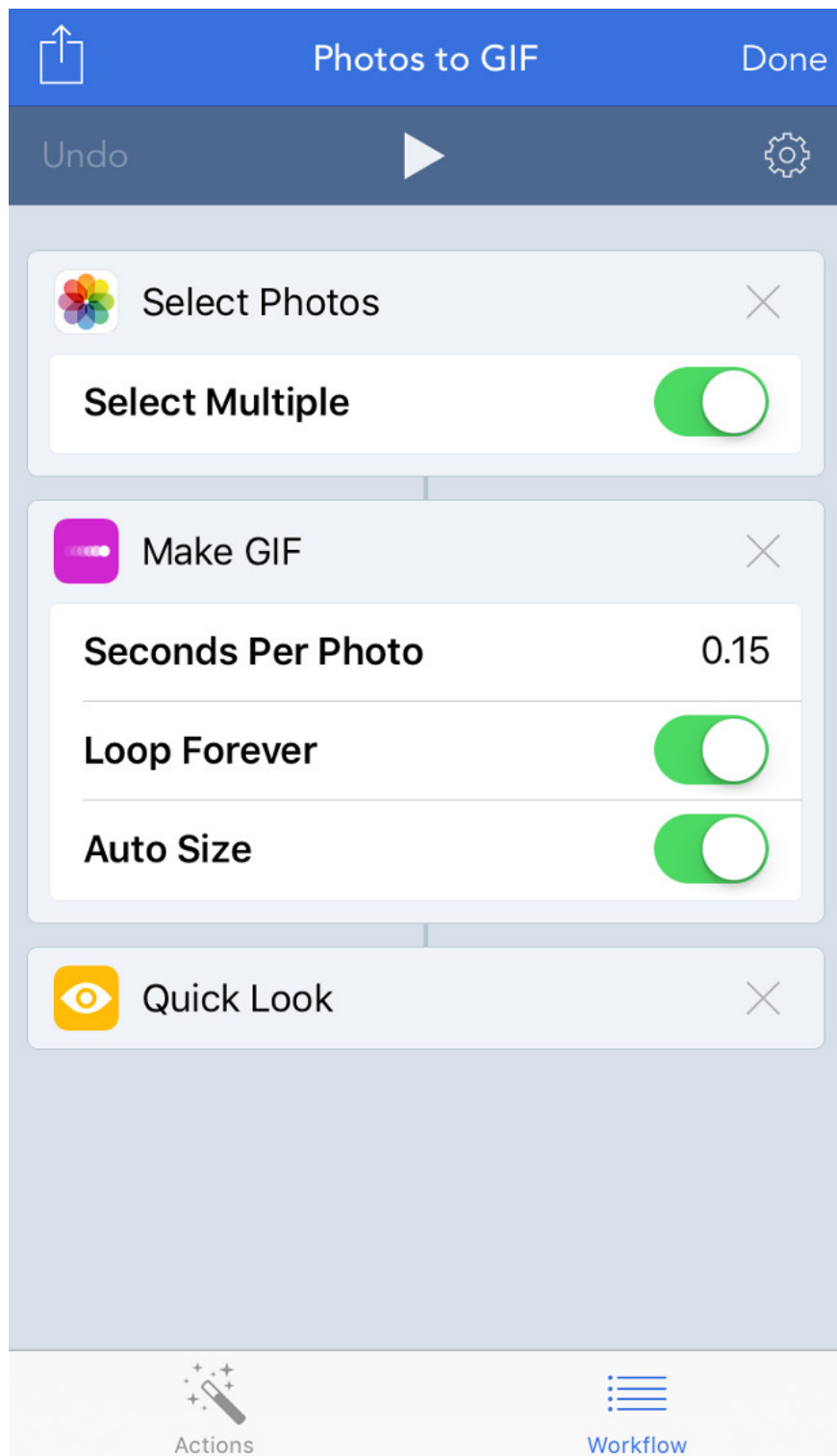
1. In this section you will see a lot of interesting and useful workflows.



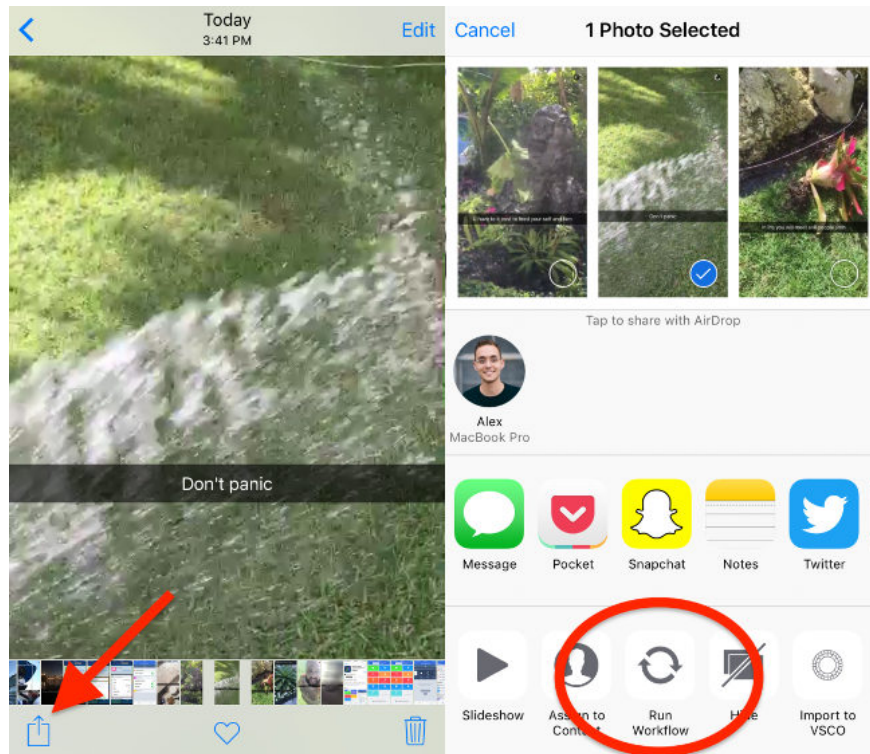
1. This workflow will create GIF images from the latest five photos in your photo library. Too convenient, isn't it?



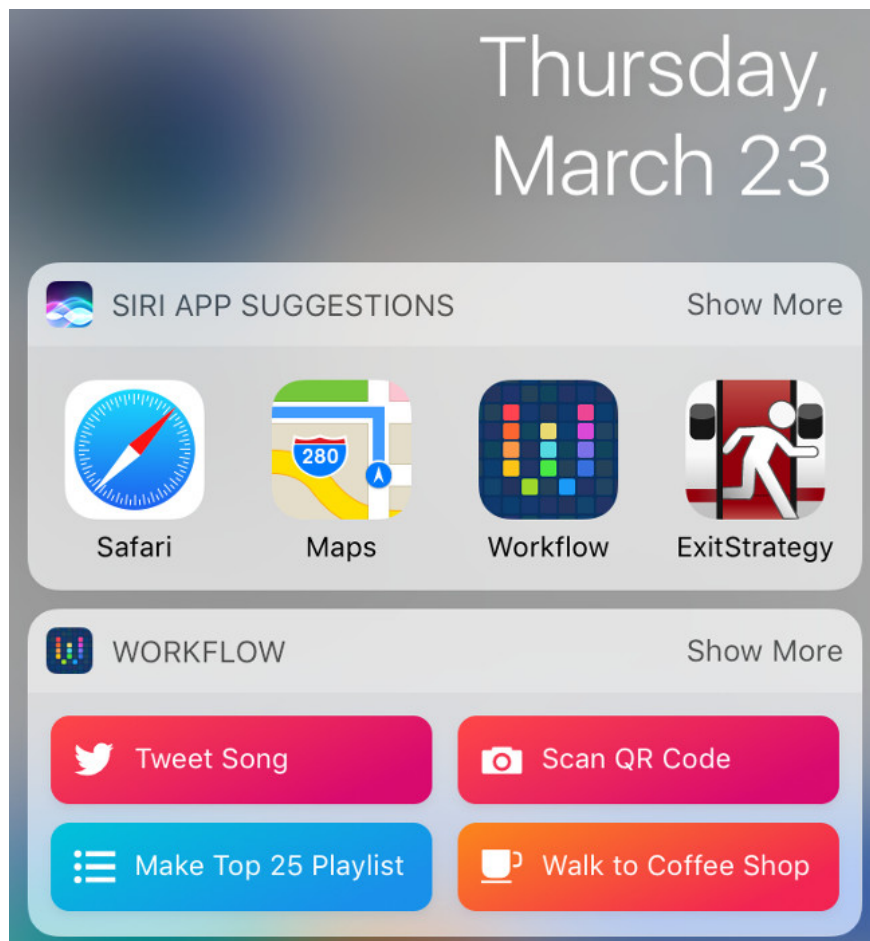
1. After the Workflow has been downloaded to the device, you can customize the workflow to your liking.



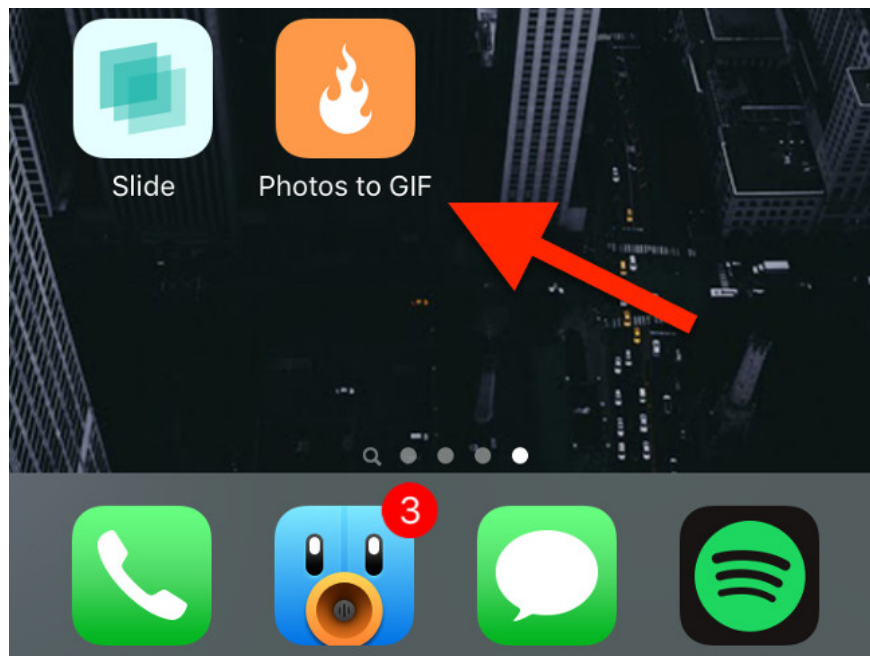
1. To use Workflow, open it at **Share** (usually this item will appear in the bottom toolbar of the application).



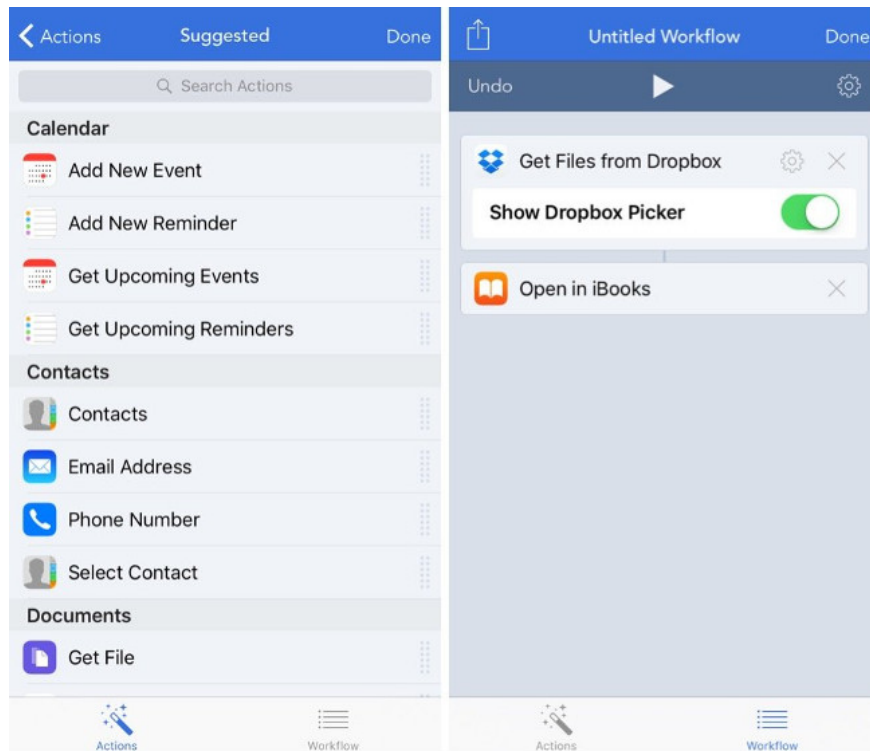
1. In addition, you can access the Workflow application through the utility area in the notification center (Notification Center).



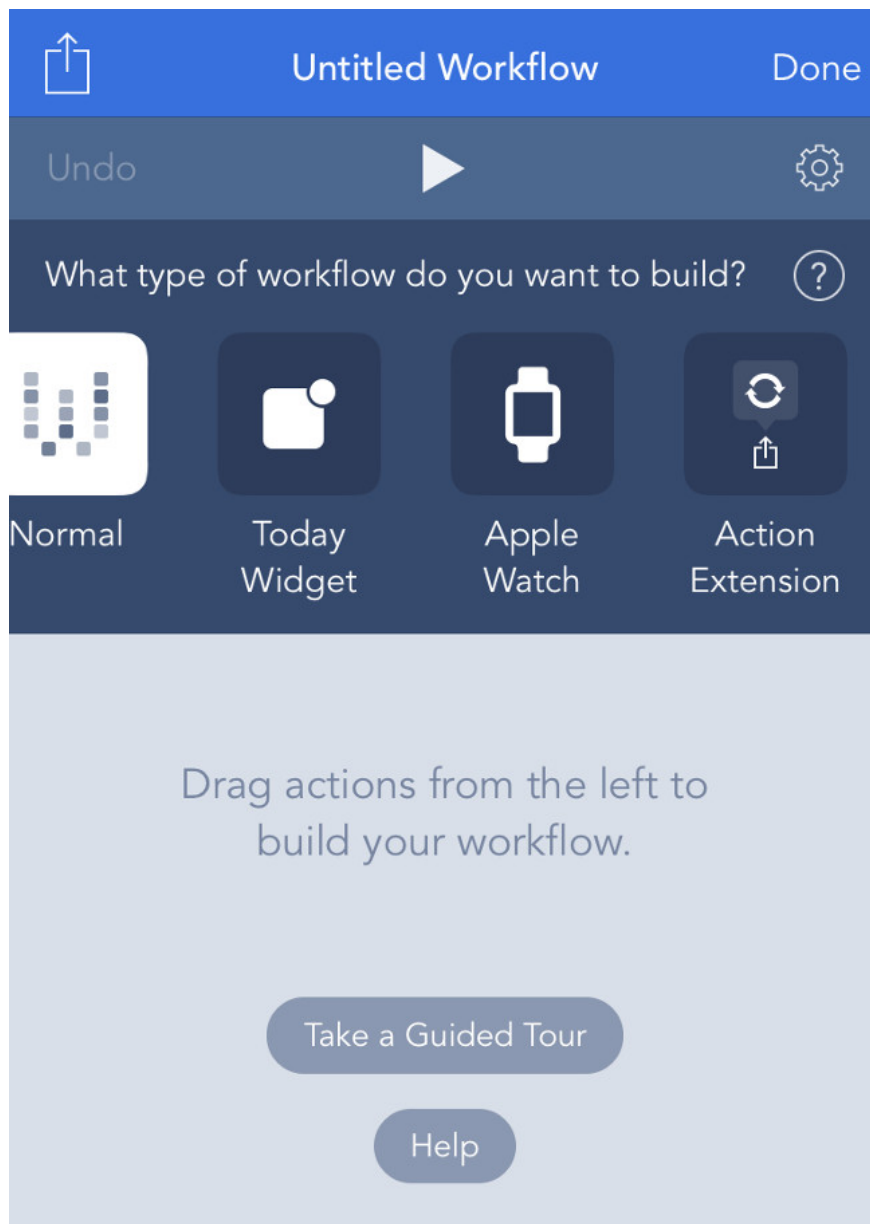
1. Adding Workflow sometimes helps you own your own application icon on the main screen.



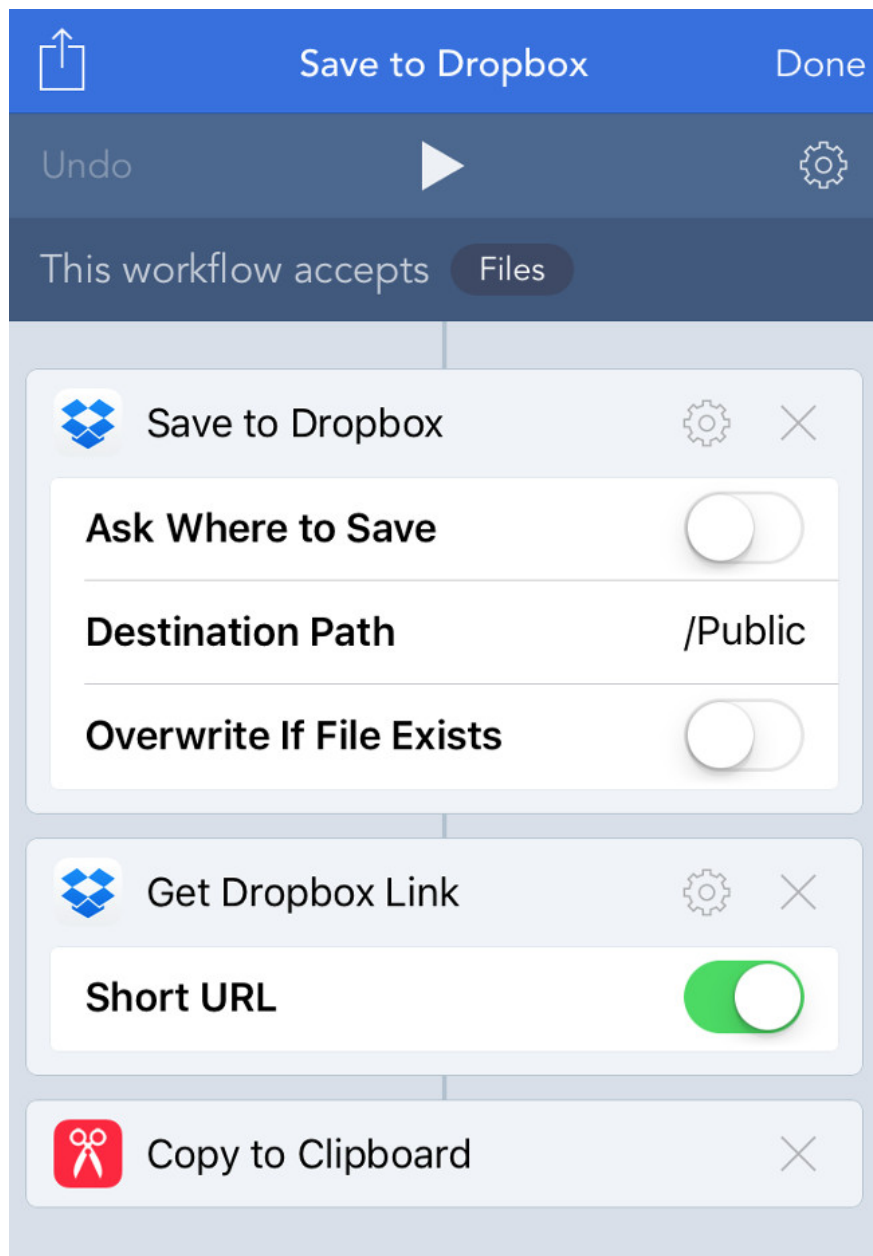
1. If you are a creative and tinkerer, you can create your own workflow by dragging items in the left window to the right window.



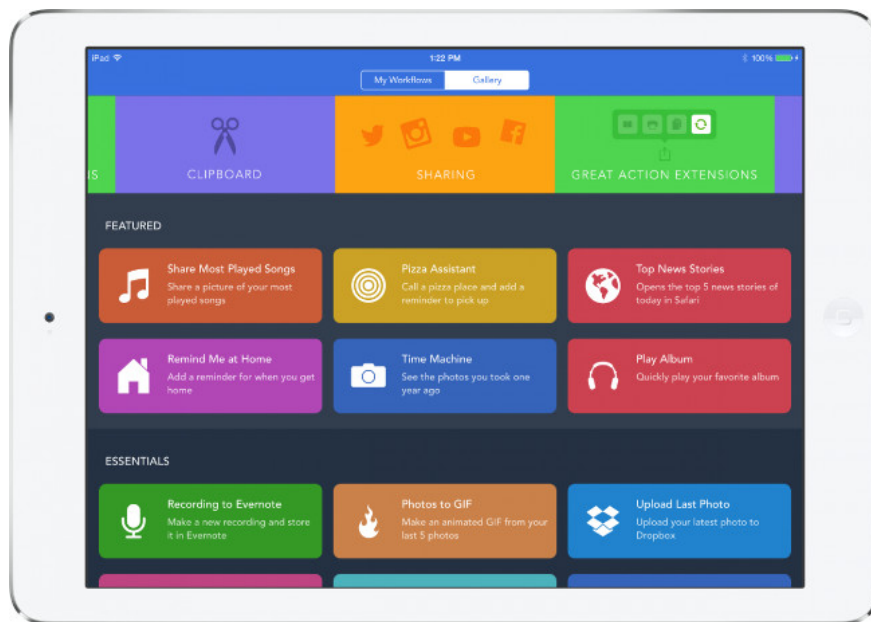
1. The application will help you find Workflow categories that match your personality.
