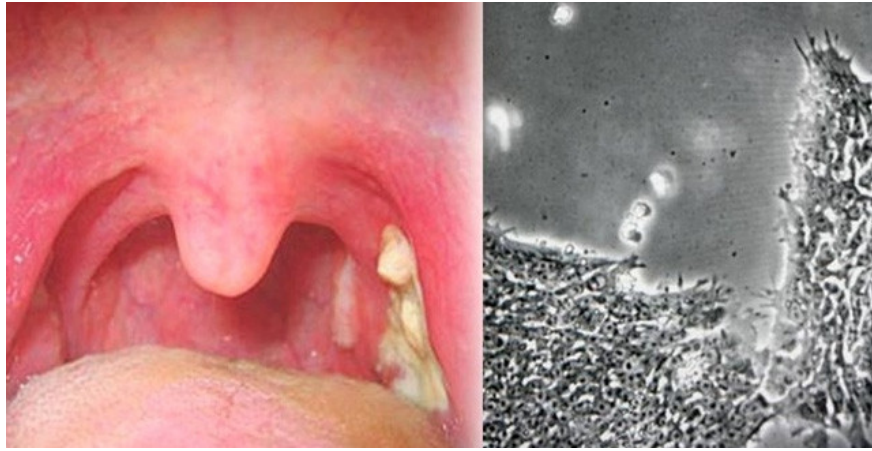
1. People can own red eyes

3. A "stronger" iPhone than NASA's computer

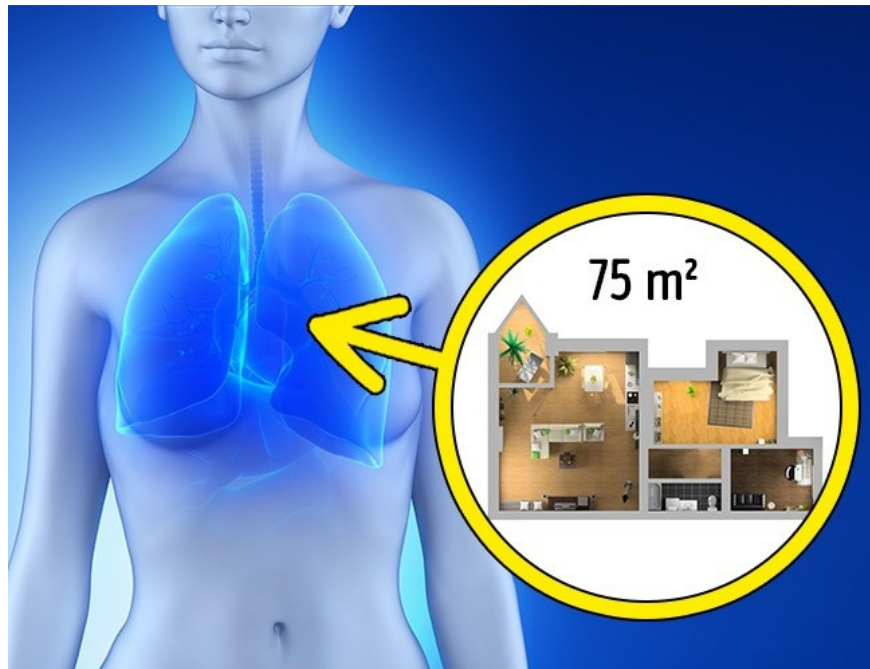


A modern iPhone could be more powerful than a computer set that NASA owned in 1969.
