Following HP, Taiwanese computer manufacturers also launched the latest two standard USB 3.0 integrated products .



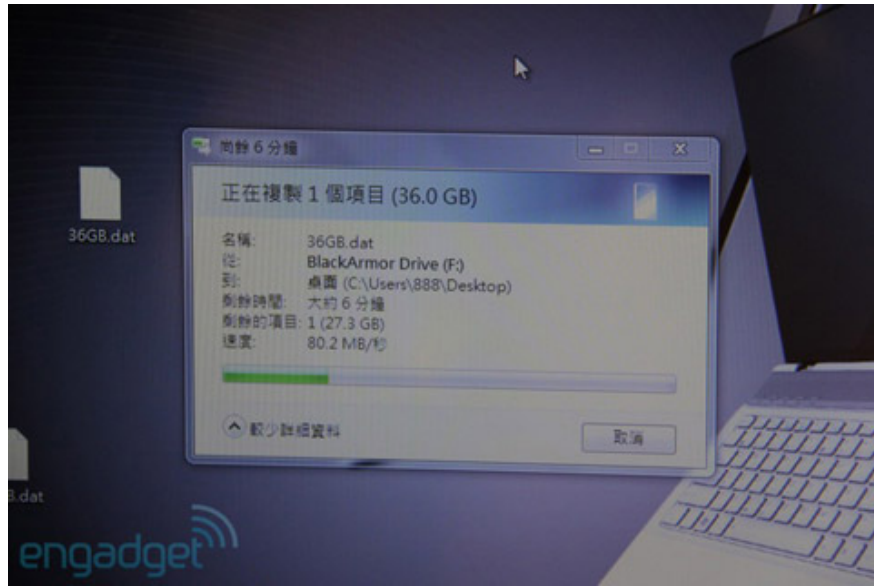
USB 3.0 will gradually replace the old standard. *Photo: Engadget .*

Only shortly after HP announced the laptop with a standard USB 3.0 port, Asus also "quickly" introduced its similar products N82 and N61. While HP's Envy 15 is considered a 15-inch screen laptop using the first USB 3.0 port, the Asus N82 and N61 can be considered the 14- and 16-inch screen laptops equivalent to using this first in the world. .

Both machines will have impressive hardware power with Intel Core i5 or i7 processors, optional discrete graphics with ATI or NVIDIA.

It is expected that new products from Taiwanese computer firms will be available in the market by the middle of this month.
