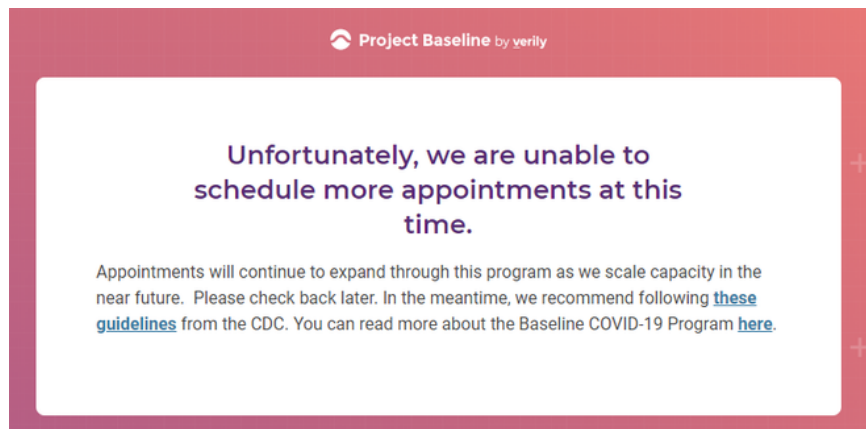


# The Google corona virus screening website in California has just opened
