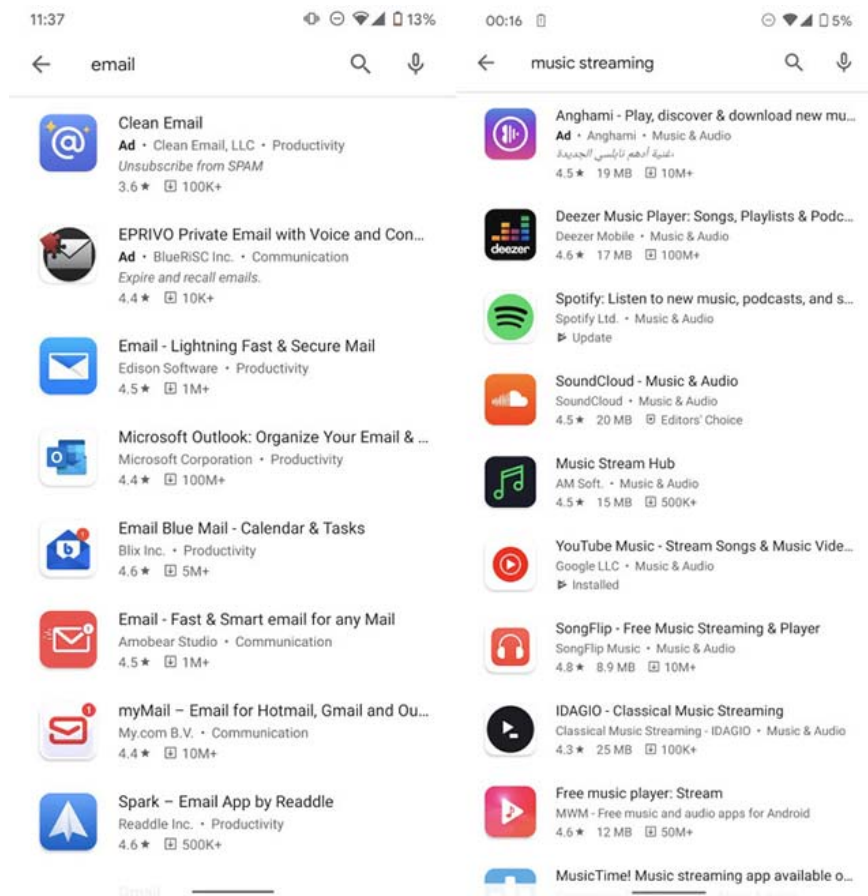


The Google Play Store displays the app's rating, capacity, and downloads right in the search results
