From 2006 to 2008, the world's largest hotel title belongs to First World Hotel in Genting Highlands of Malaysia with 7,351 rooms. But then this title belongs to The Venetian Las Vegas Hotel (USA). By 8/2015, after opening

school, two shops, a restaurant.

The narrowest street in the world

Spreuerhofstraße is located between two houses in Reutlingen (Germany). Its width ranges from 31 cm to 50 cm and is only enough for one person to cross. Spreuerhofstraße dates back to 1727 and is recognized by Guinness World Records as the narrowest street in the world in 2007.

The Romanian Parliament building in 1989 completed 12 floating floors and 8 submerged floors. To build the building, people used up to 700,000 tons of iron and copper, 900,000 m³ of wood, along with more than 1

million m³ of granite, 3,500 tons of glass, 55,000 tons of high-grade cement, 20,000 cans of sand, 1,000 tons of stone. basalt.

Northeast Greenland National Park (Denmark) was established in 1974 and expanded in 1988. Its area is up to 972,000 km² (nearly three times the area of ??Vietnam), most of the park has ice covered and is home to endemic flora and fauna such as polar bears.
