

The input () function in Python

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Input function syntax ()

```
input([prompt])
```

Parameter of input function ()

input () has a unique parameter:

1. `prompt` : is a string entered by the user.

For example

1. Input () method works in Python

```
# nh?n input t? ng??i dùng inputChuoi = input() print('Chu?i ??  
u vào là:', inputChuoi)
```

Suppose the input user input is "Website TipsMake.com". Run the program, the result is:

```
Website TipsMake.com Chu?i ??u vào là: Website TipsMake.com
```

2. Receive input from user with prompt before entering.

```
# nh?n input t? ng??i dùng inputChuoi = input('Nh?p chu?i:') print('Chu?i  
??u vào là:', inputChuoi)
```

Result:

```
Nh?p chu?i: Website TipsMake.com Chu?i ??u vào là: Website TipsMake.com
```
