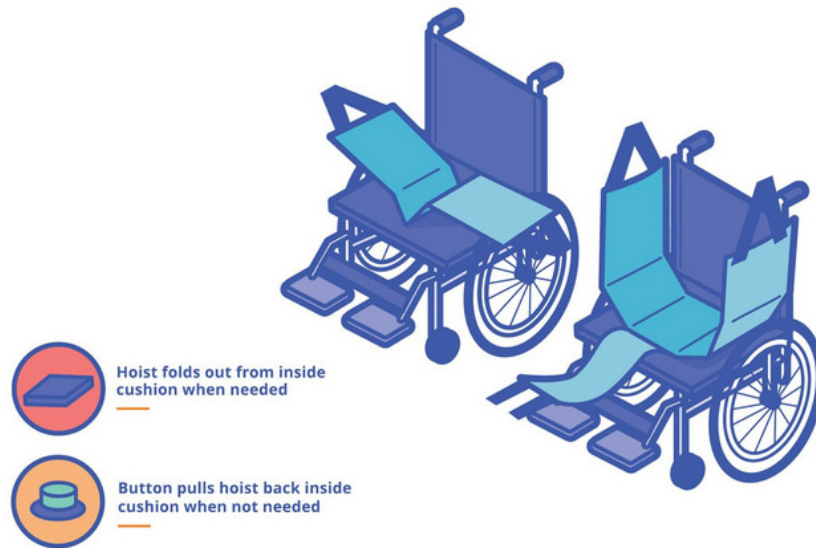

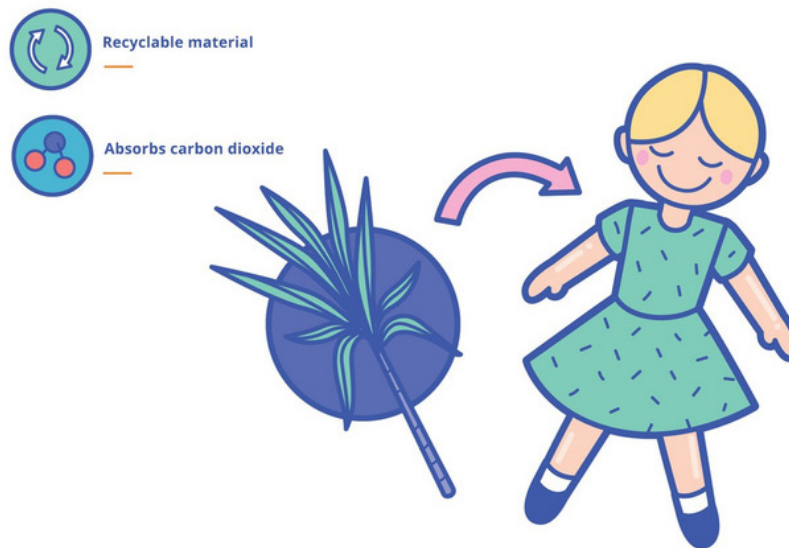

When using sugarcane plastic water bottles, Bella sees obvious benefits from it and decides to create a toy from this environmentally friendly plastic.

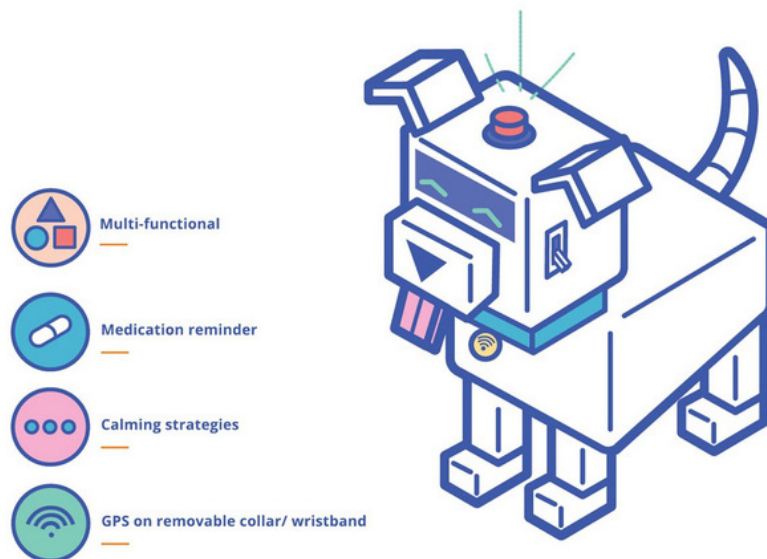


And below is the creative toy that she thought of.

12-year-old Jasmine, who created a robot dog called Dog of Technology or DOT, can help children with autism integrate with the community. And she herself programmed for this DOT robot! This is amazing!

DOT has the ability to remind time to take medicine, provide medicine when required and take measures to help autistic children keep calm and help them regulate their breathing.



In addition, DOT is equipped with light sensor, alarm system, GPS tracking necklace, eye-catching LED and tail wagging.
