

# The most common way to upgrade Windows 10 to Windows 11

How to know how to upgrade Windows 10 to Windows 11 without losing data? This is probably the question of many computer users.

How to know how to upgrade Windows 10 to Windows 11 without losing data? This is probably the question of many people who use Windows 10 operating system computers and want to update their computers to Windows 11 operating system for a better experience. If you are still wondering how to update from Windows 10 to 11, don't skip this article. Below TipsMake will introduce in detail 2 ways to upgrade Windows 10 to Win 11.

## How to upgrade Windows 10 to Windows 11 directly with a Microsoft account

This method is for users who already have a **Microsoft** account . Most of the time, every Windows laptop user has a Microsoft account. If you don't have an account, you can search and refer to other articles on how to create a Microsoft account very simply.

Once you have an account, follow these steps to **update windows 10 to windows 11** :

1. **Step 1** : Sign in to your Microsoft account.

1. **Step 2** : After logging in, go to the main interface, select **Start > Settings > Update & Security** . In the **Update and Security** section , select **Windows Update > Get Started** or **Restart now** .

1. **Step 3** : Next, wait a few seconds for the system to load. When the interface changes, select the command link account. Then, under the **Use this account** cluster , select **Continue** and then select the Microsoft account you just signed in to

1. **Step 4** : **Switch the screen to the Pick your Insider settings** interface , click on the first **Dev Channel** item (currently Microsoft only allows Windows 11 on this channel), select **Confirm**.

You can then select **Restart Now** to restart the computer at that time or **Restart Later** to restart the computer later.

1. **Step 5** : Check the settings on the device. Select **Start > Settings > Update & Security** . Go to **Windows Insider Program** to check if your Dev Channel settings are correct.

1. **Step 6**: Next, go back to **Start Menu > Settings > Update & Security > Windows Update > Check for Updates** . Then wait for Windows 10 to update to the new version. When Win 11 Insider Preview Build version 22000.51 appears, select **Download** to download.

Downloads and updates may be fast or slow depending on your computer's processor and network speed. During the Windows 11 update process, the computer will automatically restart.

When you successfully update your computer, you will see a new interface displayed and the buttons on the screen have changed, but the previous data remains intact on Windows 11.

## How to upgrade Win 10 to Win 11 using ISO file

In addition to **upgrading Win 10 to Win 11** with a Microsoft account, you can use another method: using the ISO file to upgrade.

To upgrade from Win 10 to Win 11 with an ISO file, you just need to follow these simple steps:

1. **Step 1** : Download the ISO file to your computer. Then you proceed to extract the files into a new folder as usual.

1. **Step 2** : After unpacking, go to the extracted folder and select the installation file, select **Run command as administrator** .

1. **Step 3** : When the interface changes, select Change settings to download the update method. After that, you will see two options displayed:
  1. **Download and install updates** : Click this button and all updates will be downloaded and installed. However, this option takes a lot of time and does not need to be updated immediately. It can be updated after a successful upgrade.

2. **Not right now** : Do not install the update right now. You should choose this option because **upgrading Windows 10 to Windows 11** will take less time.

Then select **Next** .

1. **Step 4:** At this time, a condition window will appear on the screen, select **Accept** to proceed with the upgrade.

1. **Step 5:** When the interface redirects, you can select **Install** to continue the installation and by default Microsoft still keeps your data. However, you can choose what to keep by clicking **Choose what to keep** .

Here, people will have 3 choices:

1. **Keep personal files apps** : Keep all your files, installed apps, and previous Windows 10 operating system settings.
2. **Keep personal files only** : This option allows you to keep only personal files. Installed applications and settings of the old operating system will be completely removed.
3. **Nothing** : Keep nothing, upgrade to a completely new version of Win 11.

If you don't want to lose data, you should choose the first option, select **Next** .

After completing the above steps, the computer will be upgraded from Win 10 to Win 11. The computer's update speed depends on the network speed and the computer's processor. After successfully upgrading, you will see a different, more beautiful screen interface.
