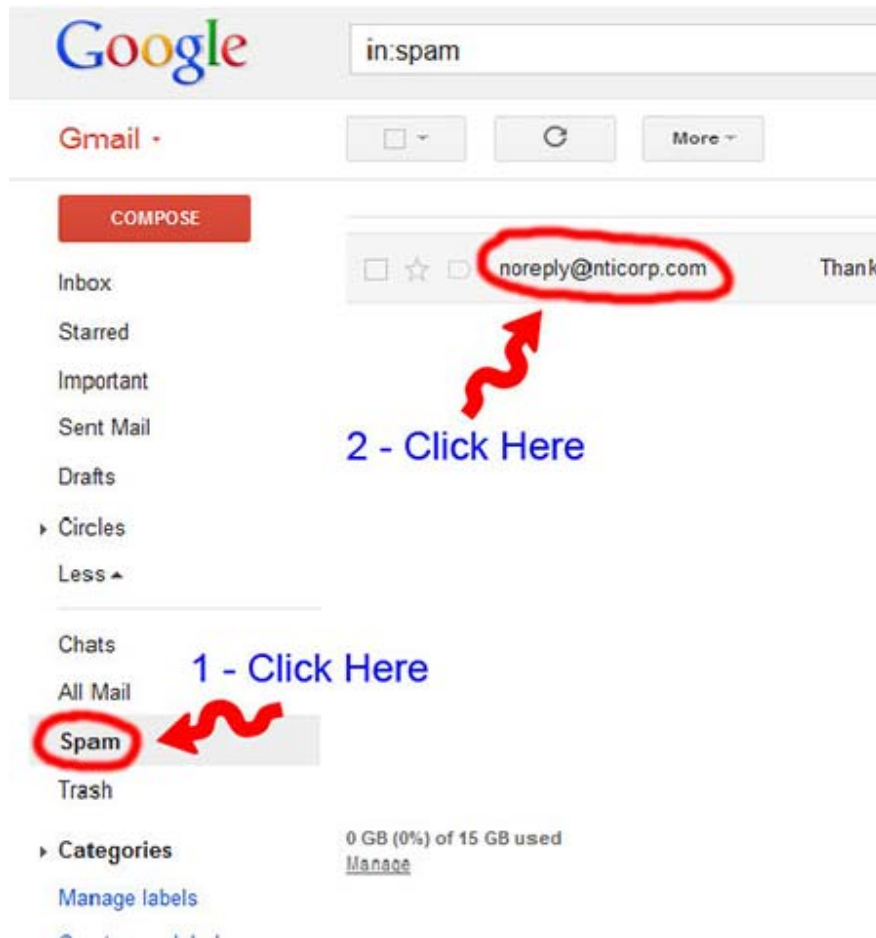
## First, 'train' your spam filter



As we have mentioned, the spam filter that your email application is equipped by will usually not work 100% perfectly in email filtering and spam detection. Therefore, there is an important task that you should implement here that is to continue 'training' the spam filter so that it can operate more perfectly. This can be done in 2 ways. First of all, whenever you encounter a case of spam that has been 'sneaked out' by the filter and entered into your inbox, it should not be merely to delete the spam, but report it. for email providers to identify them. Secondly, when it detects that email messages are not spam, but still appear in your spam folder, you should also click on that message and report back to the service provider. Their filters have been mishandled. Click the '**Not Spam**' button (or similar meaningful buttons) to report. This way, you can slowly train your spam filter so it works more efficiently over time.

**Second, train yourself to react to spam properly**

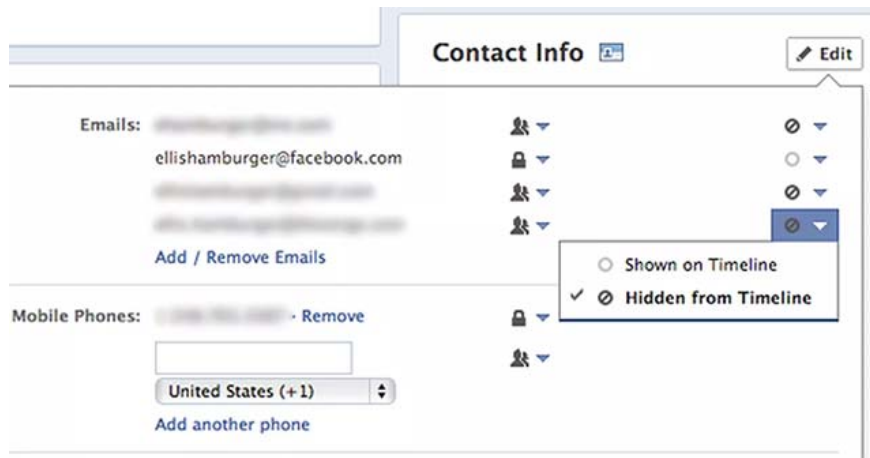


Yes, it can be said that this is one of the most important of all the email spam blocking tips we introduce to you. Broadly speaking, all security methods must always start from individual users. You have to train yourself, from the beginning, and for a long time to learn how to react to spam reasonably. If you're a regular email user, you must be familiar with spam emails appearing in your inbox almost daily. In particular, many types of spam may also look like 'genuine goods', so you need to train yourself to identify spam and handle them properly, for example, without answering or Clicking on any link in a questionable email is a basic thing that you must remember carefully. Even if an email looks relatively authentic, do not rush to click on the attached link or open the attachment with it. Just open the link or attachment when you really know the authenticity of the email. Similarly, whenever you realize that you have received spam sent from a known email address, contact the person and pass them the relevant information. That person may not be aware that his account has been hijacked and used to send spam. This effectively prevents the spread of dangerous spam emails that may contain malicious code.

### **Third, learn how to protect and if necessary, hide your email address**

You will also need to learn to protect your email address more actively from spam. There are some very important things that you need to do in this 'mission'. It is best to use one or more alternate email addresses for different purposes. For example, use a separate email to book a hotel, another email for online shopping, and another completely separate email for work . This way, the primary email address (most important ) will always be 'isolated' from unwanted spam appearing after booking, online shopping or any online activity today.



Another thing you can do to protect your email address is hide it as much as possible. Never publish your primary email address on any web page unless you are required to do so. In the event that you are required to provide an email address, if possible, provide only the secondary email address. Always remember to provide only your primary email address if you really have no other options.

## Fourth, use third-party anti-spam filter



Using third-party support tools is always a good option, as is the case for junk email filters. Using third-party anti-spam filters or extensions can help collect spam emails that bypass your default spam filter. Such third-party filters work by identifying spam when they move between your email server (server) and your email client (client). There are many different options - free as well as paid - depending on the type of device you are using as well as your level of requirements for the filter.

## Fifth, learn how to unsubscribe from services you don't need



It should be done if you can unsubscribe from regular email services if you really don't need them, emailing a Facebook notification is a common example in this case.
