Here are extremely mysterious treasures with famous death curse in the world.

Mausoleum of the First Qin Emperor

Qin Shihuang, the first emperor of China, died in September 10 BC. His tomb area is bigger than Egypt's largest pyramid, and contains a lot of gold, jewelry and thousands of exquisite terracotta statues.

During the 50 years of exploring and excavating this tomb area, archaeologists have yet to find the main mausoleum that actually contains Qin Shihuang's body. There are documents recorded that the Emperor's corpse contains thousands of traps around. Even if someone is lucky enough to survive this main mausoleum, he will

die because of poison gas when opening the door.

Koh-i-Noor diamond

Koh-i-Noor is one of the world's most famous, oldest and most expensive diamonds. The curse content of this diamond first appeared in 1306: "*Who owns this diamond will own the world, but will also taste all its misfortune. Only God, or a woman, can own it without punishment*".



And indeed those who once owned Koh-i-Noor diamonds are men who are always associated with power but suffer from misfortune, suffering and eventually die.

In the 18th century, King Humayun has since been possessed by Koh-i-Noor. He was defeated by Sher Shah Suri, but later he was also burned to death by firecrackers. Akbar, Humayun's son never holds this diamond with him.

But the next successor, Shah Jahan, took the diamond from the royal treasure, and was then overthrown by his own son.

In July 1850, Queen Victoria, England, was given this diamond. Since then, the Kohinoor diamond has always been given to the wife of the heir to the English throne.

The amber room

The amber room was built inside the Catherine palace of Tsarskoye Selo by Russian and German craftsmen, near Saint Petersburg, Russia. The walls of the room are made of pure amber and gold leaf, ornate mirrors.



In 1716, the room was completed, the room value was estimated at \$ 142 million and was named the 8th Wonders of mankind.

At the end of World War II, the amber room was occupied by the Nazis. The last time this treasure was seen was in 1943 before it completely mysteriously disappeared. There are many different theories about the fate of this room but so far no one knows its location. But those who were involved in this amber room had mysteriously died, making it a scary treasure.

Ark of the Covenant - The Ark of the Covenant

According to the Bible, the Lord instructed Moses to create the dharma chamber, containing 10 Commandments. This box is made of acacia wood and pure gold.



For Jews this is the most sacred relic of the nation and contains great strength. According to legend, the ark helped turn the Jordan River so that the Jews fled when expelled from Egypt.

According to the ancient records, two poles to lift the ark should never be discarded, during the process of moving the trunk needs to be raised to the shoulder and anyone who touches this box must die.

After the Babylonians overthrew the kingdom of Israel, the ark suddenly disappeared. Many believe that it was God who took the ark, others said that the Jews had hidden it. So far, the existence of the ark is still a mystery and many people are still searching for it.

Treasure filled with gold and cruel curse

According to the Apache tribe on Arizona's Superstition, there is a cursed treasure. According to legend, anyone who touches the treasure will be subject to the revenge of the Thunder god, so the people of this tribe never dare to look at the treasure.

In 1800, a man named Jacob Waltz found the gold mine but died before revealing the location.

In 1931, Adolph Ruth, a treasure hunter, disappeared while searching for a gold mine. Two years later, his body was found with a Latin note next to "Veni Vidi Vici" which means " *I came, I saw and I conquered* ". This message shows that Adolph Ruth found the gold mine before his death.

So far, many people have died because of finding this rare gold mine. Most recently, Jesse Capen, his body was found in 2012, three years after he began his journey to find the gold mine.
