The world's largest mobile phone

This slider keyboard phone has a size of 4.5 mx 4 mx 0.9 m when the "spread" is full. Volume up to 158.7 kg.

Most of the focus only reached the lens of Street View car 1.2 times. But in 2010, a British national woman named Wendy Southgate was 'photographed' by the Google car 43 times when she was walking with her dog.

At an event in Hong Kong in 2003, 1,912 people within 1,19 minutes assembled 961 personal computers. This record has been recorded in the Guinness book of the world.

The most popular video ever

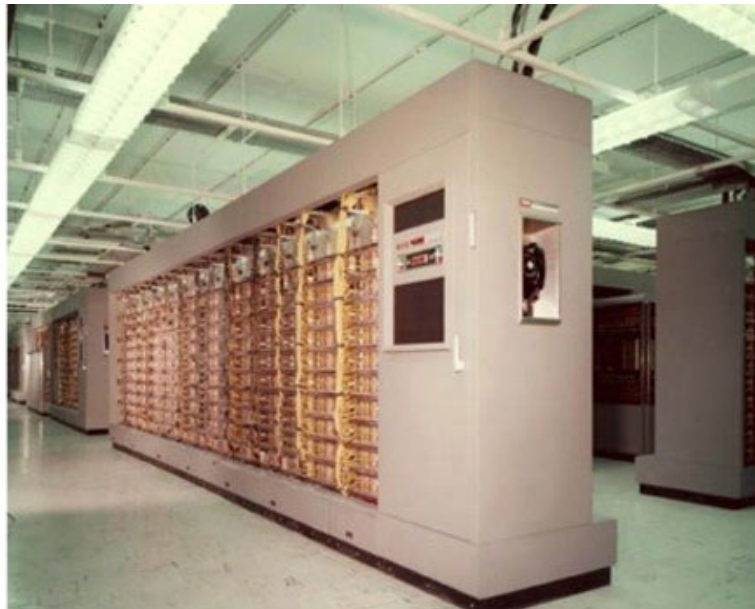

SAGA is a 'myth' about production costs, size and weight

Built in the 1960s at a cost of about \$ 8 billion, SAGE is the most expensive computer for IBM and RAND. SAGE also holds a record of size when it occupies an area of ??610 m2. Weighing up to 250 tons, this machine is responsible for monitoring signals from the US air force radar in real time.
