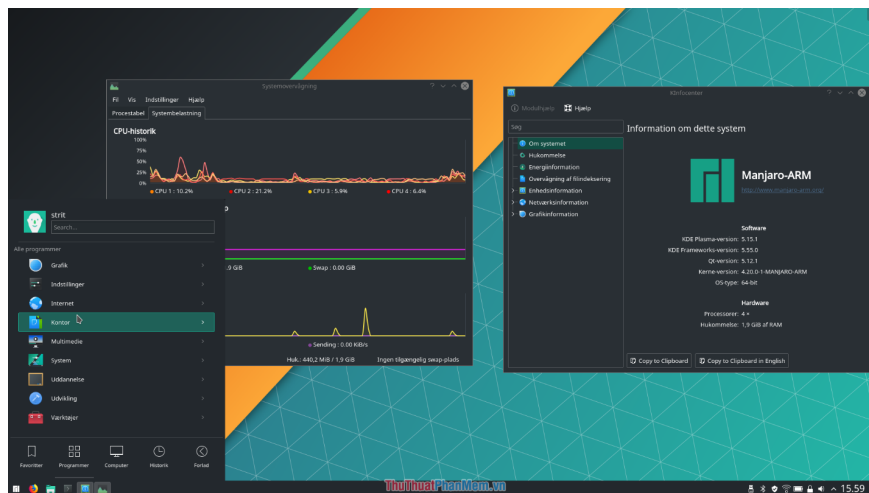

2. Linux Mint



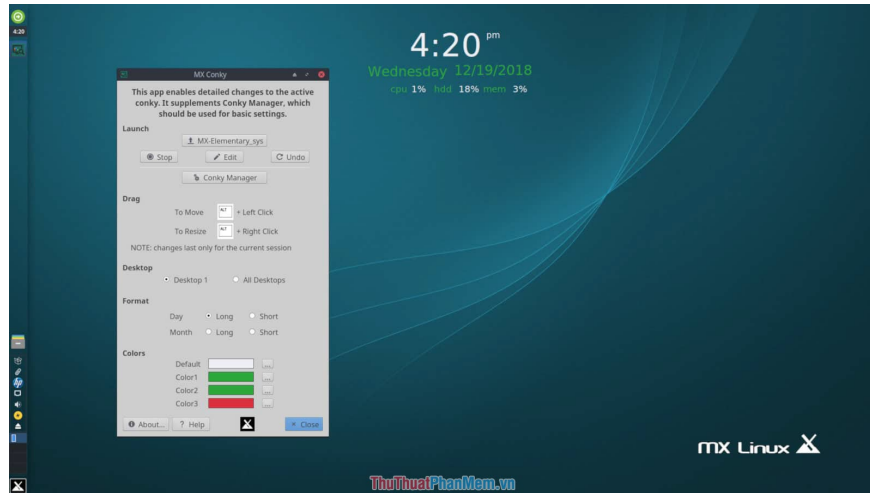

3. Manjaro



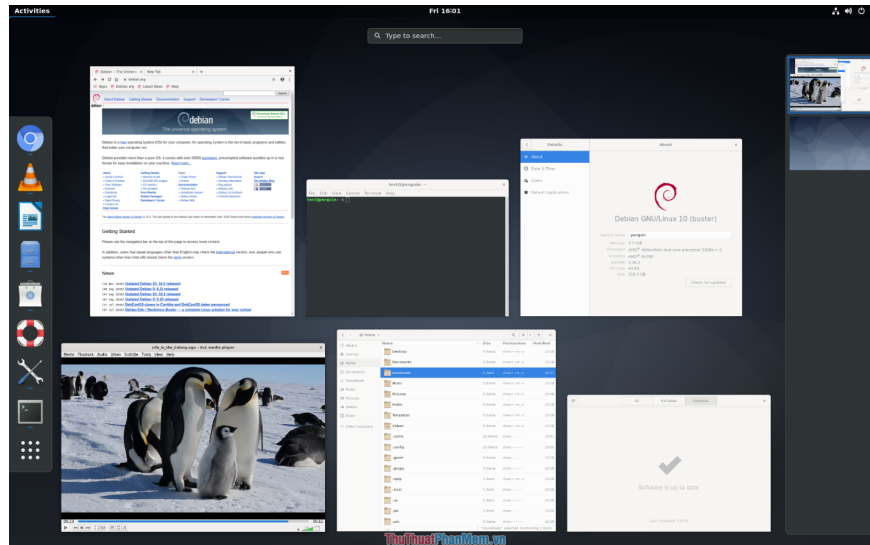

4. MX Linux



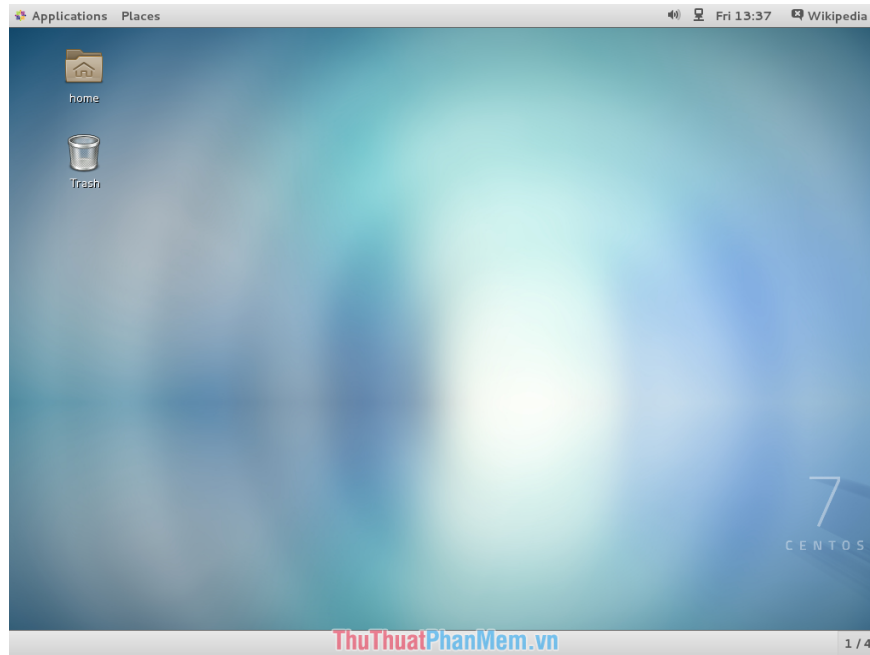
