In 2012, legendary Whitney Houston - "Queen of Pop", who won six Grammy Awards and nominated 25 times, passed away at the age of 48.

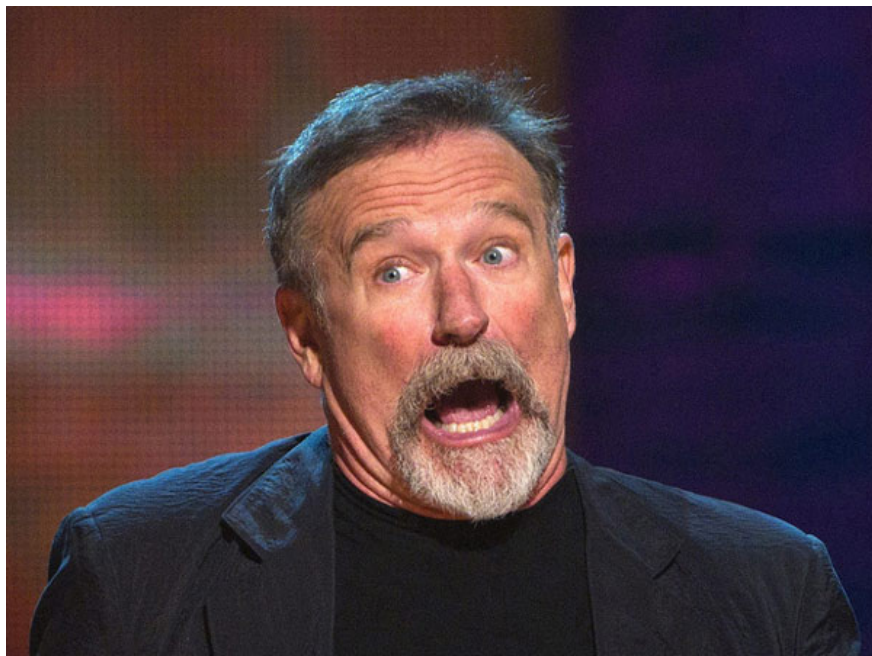
2013: Paul Walker

2017: Hurricane Irma



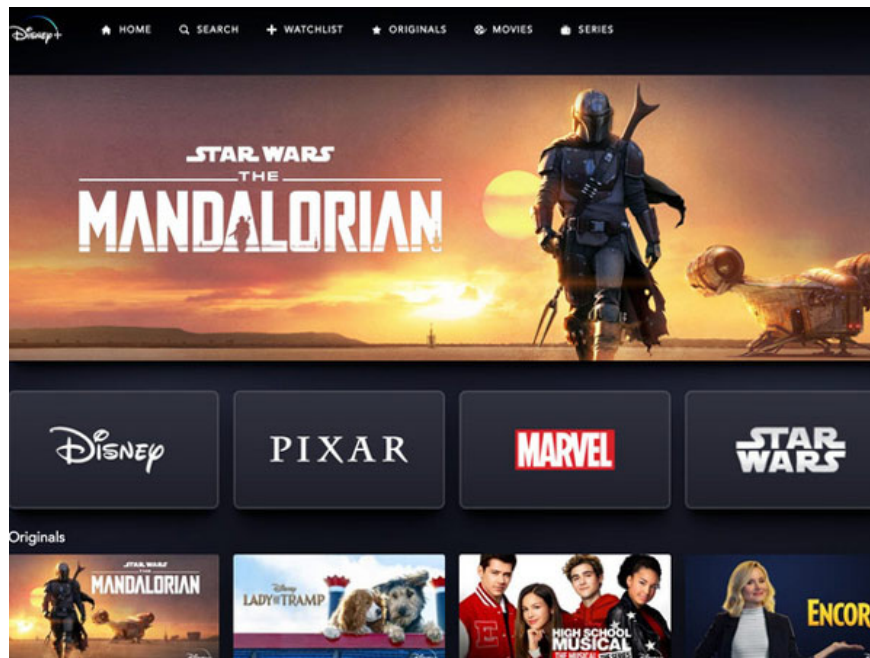
