

The most secure way to edit content in PowerPoint

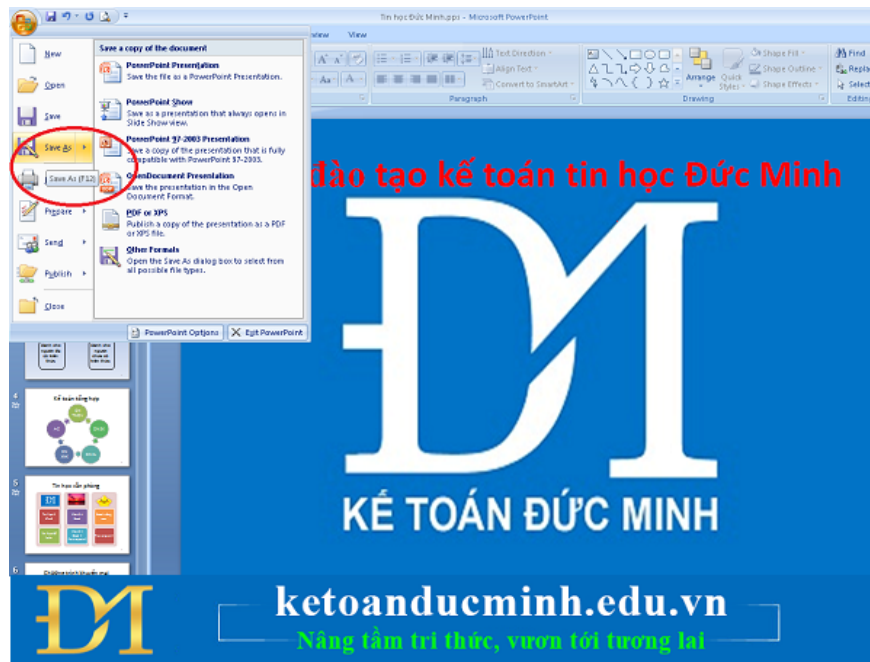
Do you have a Powerpoint presentation and must send it to others who want to keep the content, do not want to edit it?

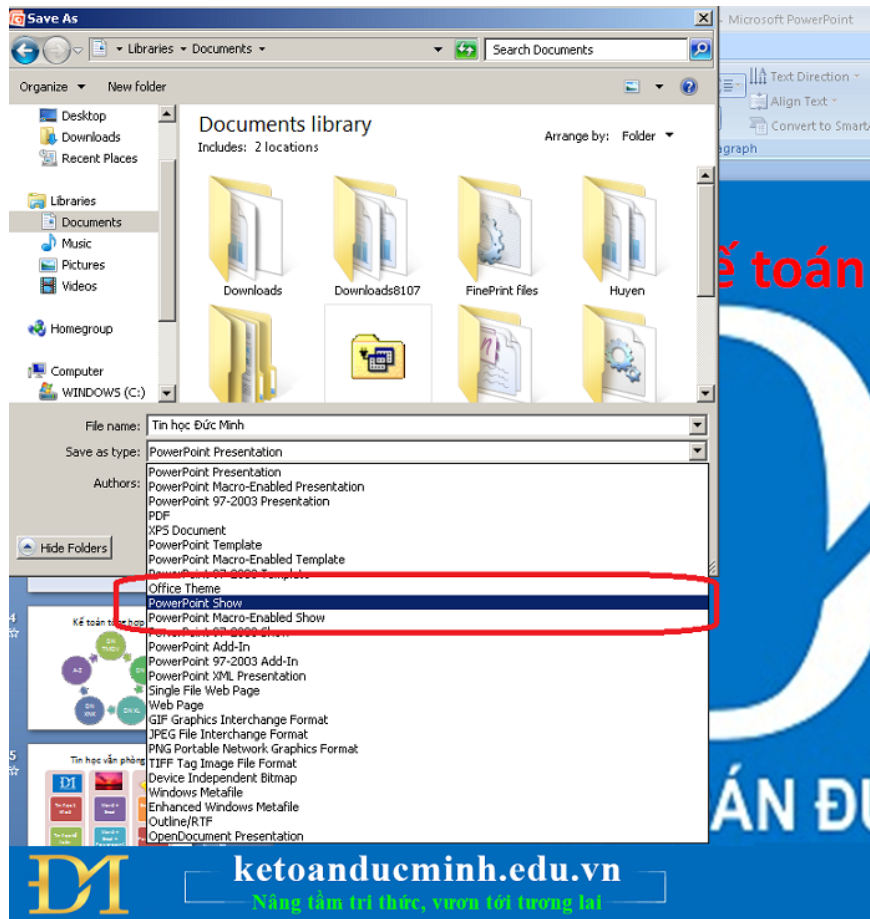
Step 1:

You open your presentation as usual. Then choose Save As (or F12) to save the file as a new file with a different name.



Step 2:

In the Save As Type section select Powerpoint Show.



Step 3:

Your file has been saved as a presentation. So when opening the file, it shows in full screen mode (Full Screen) - the slide show should always be unable to edit the content, or copy the copy.
