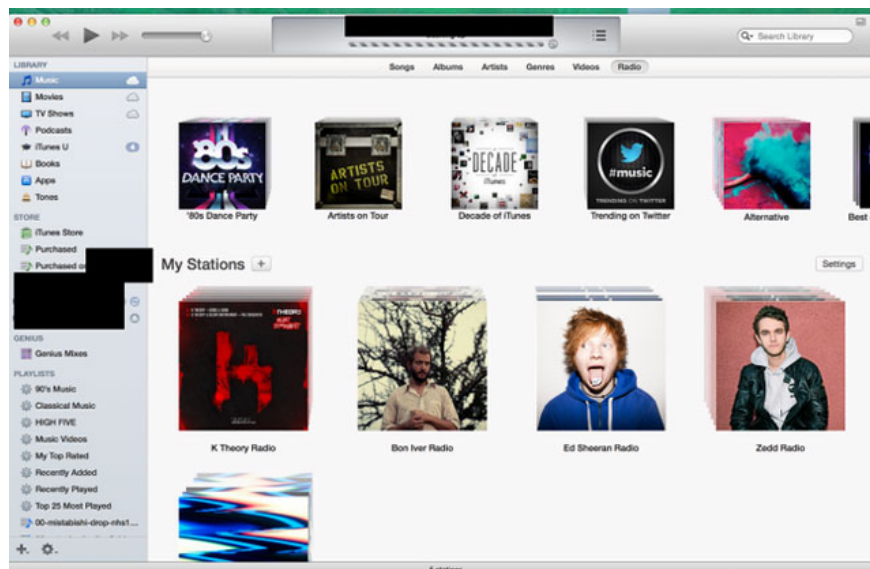

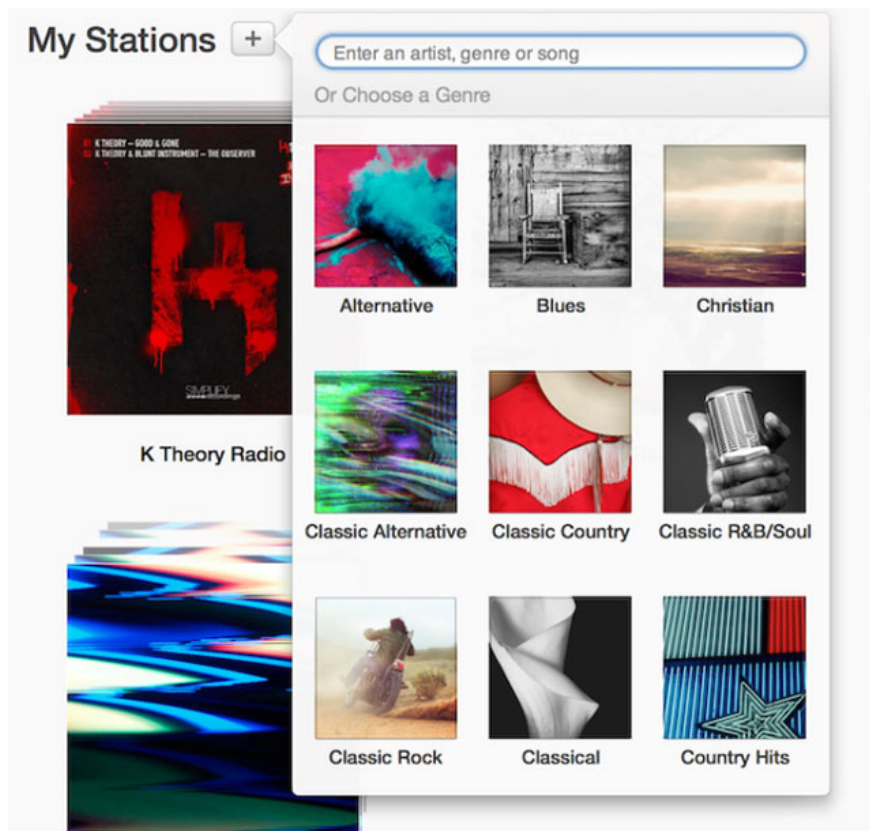
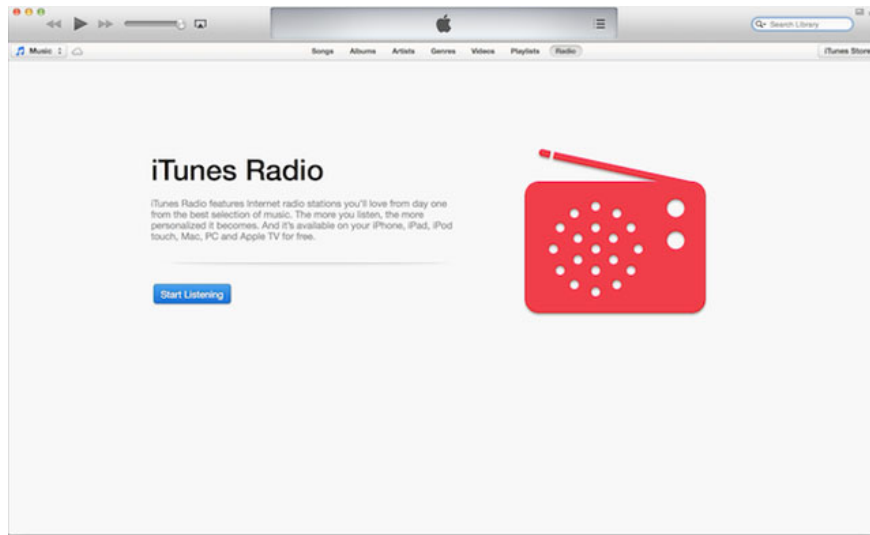
This shows that when the **new** version of **iTunes** is officially released to users, this radio service will also be integrated into this software.

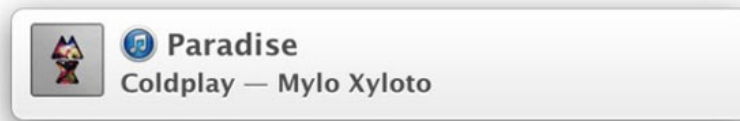
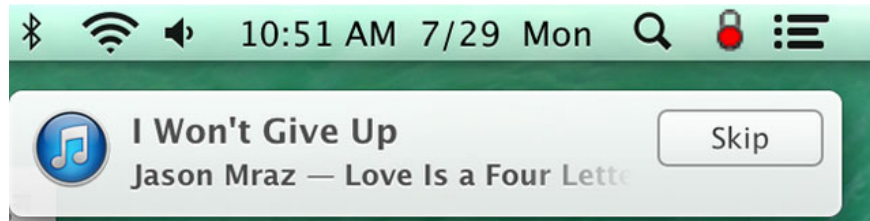
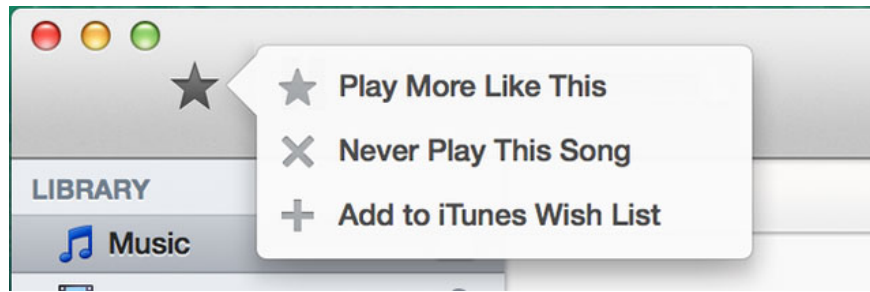
iTunes Radio is a free radio service that Apple launched with iOS 7 last month. This service allows users to stream radio and music channels for free, but users will be subject to advertisements during use. To remove ads, users must register to use the iTunes Match service.

iTunes Radio is also available on the first beta versions of iOS 7. Apple TV is now also integrated with this service.
