Many recent sources show that Apple will launch a **new MacBook Air on the 10th of this year** at their WWDC 2013 event. Besides upgrading to Haswell chip for MacBook Air to help the device have better battery life, the source also said that this supermodel laptop of Apple will have the same microphone system as on the MacBook Pro (Retina version).



In addition, a recent source added that **MacBook Air 2013** will be equipped with **WiFi 802.11ac** chip. In April, the code in OS X 10.8.4 also showed that the operating system supports the new Broadcom chipsets for higher download speeds and data streams. And very coincidentally, OS X 10.8.4 was released the day before, about a week before the new MacBook Air was released.

Some information also said that Apple may slightly lower prices for high-end MacBook Air in some countries. In addition, the new MacBook Air will also be ready to be released soon after the "Apples App" introduced its products at WWDC 2013 because a certain amount of goods has been shipped before to stores around the world.

In addition to the new MacBook Air, Apple will also announce **iOS 7**, **OS X 10.9**, and **new Radio** service .
