

The new Windows 11 build supports the option to draw stickers on the desktop

Remember the Windows 11 builds released in May 2022 added a new 'personalization' feature that allows users to place stickers on the desktop. And most recently, Microsoft has added the option to draw stickers on the desktop for the new build 25174 of Windows 11.

As a new hidden feature in Windows 11 22H2 and later versions, Desktop Stickers allows users to personalize the desktop with stickers with different themes or draw the stickers themselves using built-in tools. However, users can only use the sticker drawing feature on the desktop from build 25174 onwards.

It is worth noting that the Desktop Stickers feature still has some limitations that Microsoft has yet to overcome. Specifically, to use this feature, users must set the wallpaper in full screen mode, and stickers (stickers) are not supported in multi-screen mode.

Because the sticker insert feature is only available on build 25174 onwards, so to use this feature you need to update Win 11 to the latest version.
