

# The newly launched Edge Chromium browser has an installation error

Some users reflect on the process of installing Edge Chromium on Windows, which displays a completely different language they didn't even know, Spanish.

Microsoft officially launched its new version of Edge Chromium yesterday (January 15, 2020) after more than a year of unveiling the project. Currently, users can download this browser for any device, including Windows, macOS, Android and iOS.

However, after only one day of launch and download permission, the browser appeared to be vulnerable. Specifically, some users reflect on the process of installing Edge Chromium on Windows, which displays a completely different language that they do not know, Spanish.

Currently, Microsoft has admitted to language errors when installing Edge Chromium. The tech company said the technical team is looking to fix this error as quickly as possible so as not to affect the user experience.

Microsoft adds that this bug is not too serious and does not affect users much.

According to the Neowin site, the cause of this language setting error is that users download the Spanish version of Edge Chromium, so the language will appear in Spanish instead of English when installed.

Users in Vietnam are not affected by this error, so you can feel free to download and experience offline.
