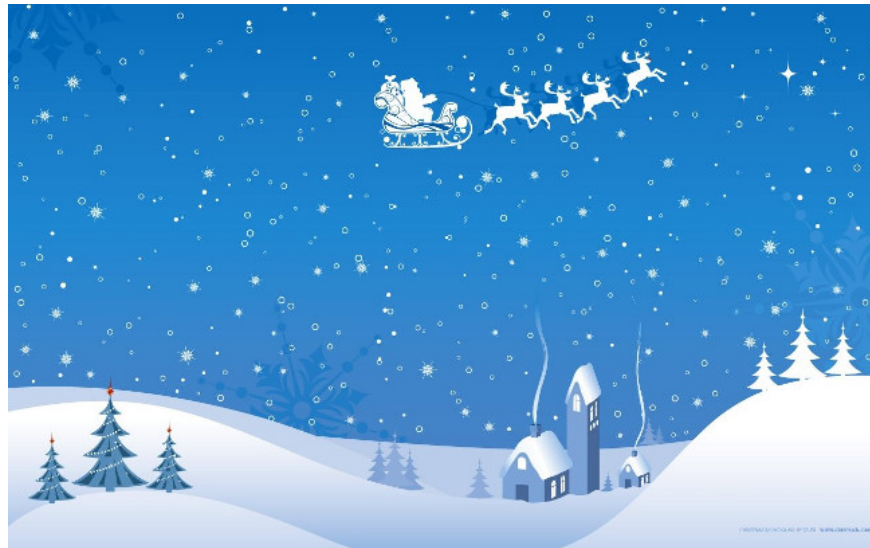


The origin and meaning of Christmas
