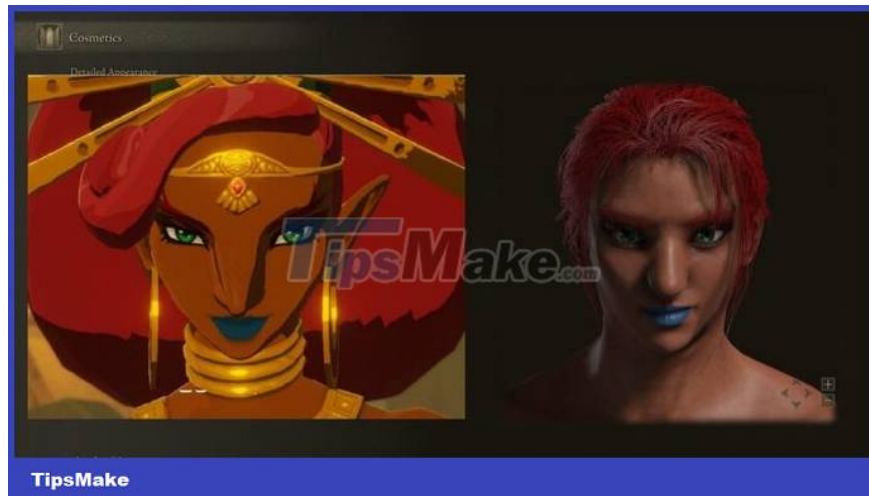


The queen of the Gerudo clan appeared in the land of Elden Ring

And with his extremely rich imagination, an Elden Ring player recently created the queen of the Gerudo race - Urbosa, from the distant Hyrule land of The Legend of Zelda: Breath of the game. Wild.



The gamer who created this Urbosa character is known by the Reddit account name Vextalyst. This guy's posts show how much he pays attention to every detail. Typically, it is not only recreating Urbosa's features such as the color of hair, eyes, skin and facial features, but Vextalyst has adjusted to the character's characteristic blue eye color.



It is not a waste that Elden Ring received the most complete score from game reviewers. When new details and secrets are discovered when it comes to mysterious items, NPCs, game bosses, and the Elden Ring's world environment are "revealed", then it's time to enter the human game. players were fascinated by the custom character creation.



In addition to Urbosa, there have been a few characters from other games that "set foot" in the Lands Between through custom character creation, such as Ciri of The Witcher universe or CJ from the game Grand Theft Auto. : San Andreas .
