

# The reason why you should assemble yourself is a Hackintosh computer instead of buying a Mac from Apple

Below are the weaknesses of Apple-made computers compared to a Hackintosh.

Hackintosh is a computer assembled from many different components that can run MacOS on non-Apple hardware. Hackintosh is the choice of those who do not like to buy Macs from Apple because they are high priced, poorly customized and do not meet what they want.

Below are the weaknesses of Apple-made computers compared to a Hackintosh.

**Compared to an expensive Mac, Hackintosh is cheaper and you can still get the Apple experience.**

YouTuber Snazzy Labs only needs to spend 350 USD (more than 8 million) to assemble a Hackintosh system that has the same performance as Apple models by January 2018. This console can run applications only for Macs, such as Final Cut Pro X .



A self-assembled computer array must be installed with a copy of the MacOS operating system to be called Hackintosh. And the only legal and legitimate way to get a copy of MacOS is to copy from the Mac you own. But this may cause you to violate Apple's terms of service that you agreed to when purchasing a Mac.

Currently, Hackintosh communities on the Internet have not encountered any problems with Apple about copyright issues. But does not mean that this will not happen, the problem is when.

In 2013, YouTuber Marques Brownlee assembled a Hackintosh staging because at that time no Apple model could meet his requirements.

**The computers created by Apple do not completely satisfy everyone, and often come with components that not everyone needs.**

For example, many users want to buy an Apple laptop with a 15-inch screen, but the only model that meets that need is the 2016 MacBook Pro that comes with a luxury hardware discrete graphics chip - one chip with power that not everyone needs. But because of the big screen, users have no other choice.

If you want to get your product right and have it affordable, then assembling a Hackintosh assembly yourself is the best choice. This is one of the causes of Marquess Brownlee, YouTuber specializing in technology assembling themselves a Hackintosh system not long ago.

**The cost of repairing a Hackintosh if broken is easy and much cheaper than fixing a Mac at Apple.**

With a self-assembling Hackintosh array, you can remove a broken component yourself and easily find components on stores that sell computer equipment instead of bringing the machine to the repair shop. .

But for Apple Macs you will have to bring it to an Apple Store or repair shops authorized by Apple to fix it because Apple components are exclusive and extremely difficult to replace.

YouTuber Peter Paul Chato said that his self-made Hackintosh had broken the power supply. He removed the part, went to the Canada Computer store to buy another power supply and installed it. After only 2 hours, Peter was able to use his Hackintosh. If the situation happens to any Mac yourself, you'll have to take it to Apple Store to fix it and wait for 3 days to 1 week to get it back.

The only drawback is that you have to take responsibility for the Hackintosh you are self-assembled because it will not have technical support.

With a Hackintosh computer self-assembling, you can customize its appearance as you like. Not only can macOS be installed on many non-Apple laptops and desktops, but you can also hunt for the most compatible components to install a Hackintosh desktop yourself. With laptops, you only need to buy products that ensure key components like microprocessors, and other components such as RAM and hard drives can be customized.

YouTuber Dom Esposito assembled a Hackintosh itself, running AMD's Ryzen processor.

It sounds interesting, but assembling a Hackintosh machine is something that not everyone can do. It requires modifying many settings that most people cannot do and to install macOS on Hackintosh, you will need to use some specialized tools of Hackintosh experts. In addition, the selection of compatible components will be quite limited.

Of course, if you want and are determined to assemble Hackintosh yourself, nothing is impossible. On the internet with lots of tutorials and the Hackintosh community also created quite a few lists of compatible components, start to learn before you start working.
