

# The recently released Windows 10 KB4535996 update has received the blue screen of death

Update KB4535996 has encountered an error of unable to install. Some users also encounter the blue screen of death - BSOD after installation causes the system to freeze.

A few days ago, Microsoft released Cumulative Update (KB4535996) for Windows 10 1903 (May 2019) and 1909 (November 2019) to optimize performance and battery, and fix user feedback. In the process of using such as the search bar does not work or printer connection error. This is an optional update so Windows will not automatically update for users.

However, according to user feedback on the Microsoft website, the KB4535996 update was subjected to an installation failure. Specifically, when downloading and installing the update to 100%, the computer automatically reboots, the blue screen appears and continues to install to 6%, then reboot. This means that Windows cannot complete the installation of update KB4535996.



Some users also encounter the blue screen of death - BSOD after installing KB4535996, causing the system to freeze.

However, after uninstalling this installation, the computer can work normally again.

In short, users should wait for Microsoft to fix the error, not download and install the optional update KB4535996. If you have already downloaded, installed, and unfortunately encountered the above errors, you should try to uninstall the update by clicking on **Windows** -> selecting **Settings** -> selecting **Update & security** -> selecting **View update history** -> selecting **Uninstall updates** line is okay.
