According to Express.co.uk, Dr. Parag Madhukar Dhakate, the Indian Forest Service defender, said the creature will remain a mystery until scientific analyzes are completed.

He said: *"It's like a dinosaur, but we can't say anything until all the tests done are published later."*

"The non-bird dinosaurs have become extinct in the past 65 million years, but it is similar to theropod, a subspecies of dinosaurs, including possibly bipedal predators, but a massive skeleton," he said. Long can not be

Dr. Dhakate said the specimen was sent to biologist Bahadur Kotlia, of Kumaun University, to analyze animal carcasses and its history.

There are suggestions that this corpse could be a dead fetus of goats, however, the mystery is still unresolved, Express.co.uk reported.

Meanwhile, the world's largest dinosaurs were discovered 150 million years ago. They were identified as giant mammals, at least 35 meters long and weighing more than 35,000 kg, according to a new study.

First discovered 8 years ago in Plagne village of France, in the Jura Mountains, many dinosaur discoveries paved the way for a series of excavations in the area and discovered many long-term dinosaurs. more than 150 meters.
