Although quite large in size, this scorpion has very little toxicity, is gentle and does not pose a danger to humans, so they are often kept as pets.

The main food of emperor scorpions is termites, crickets, cockroaches and cereals. In nature, they make caves in termite nests and are the favorite food of mammals, reptiles and amphibians.
