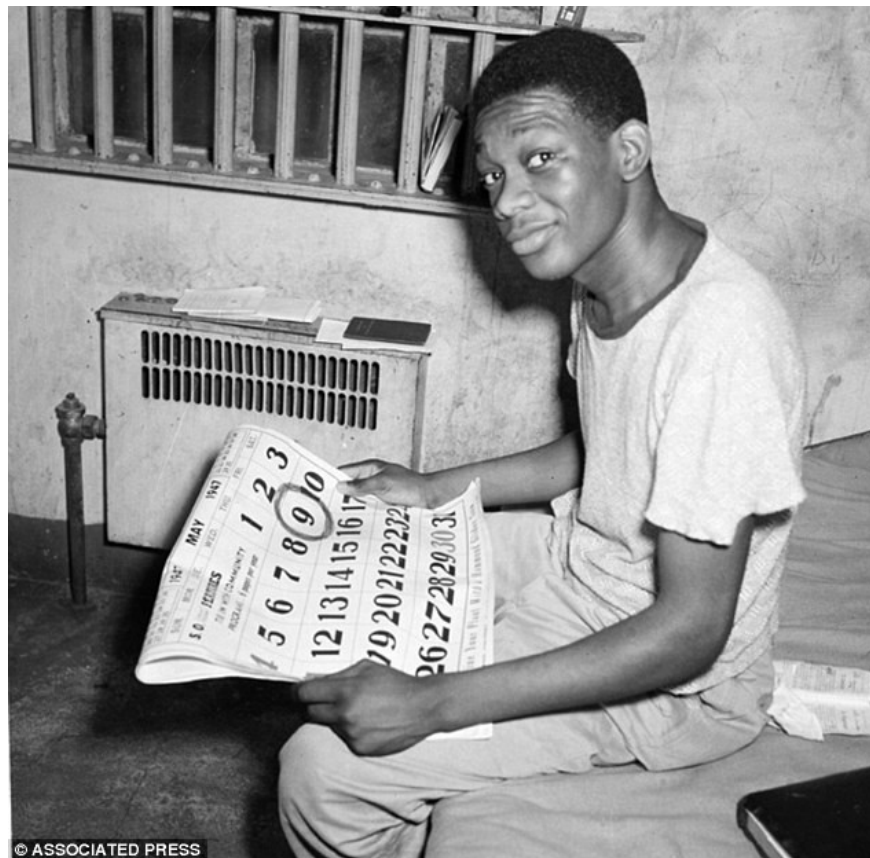

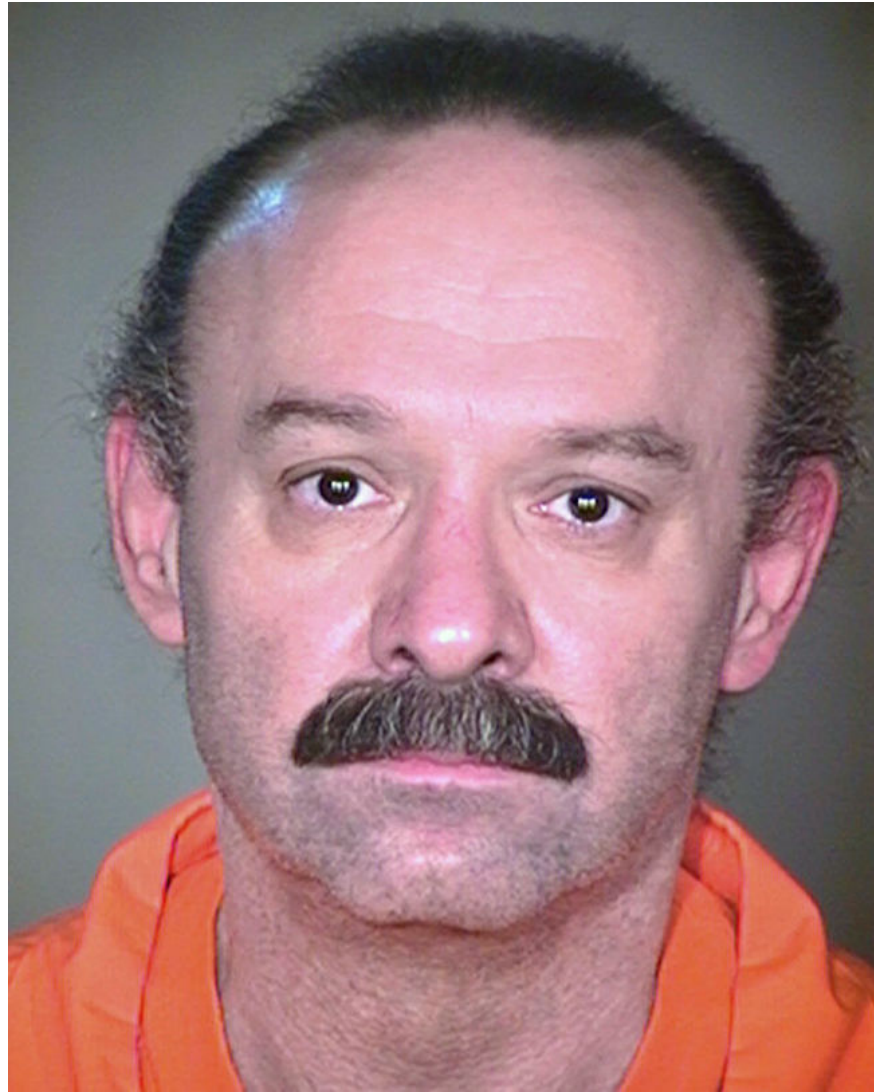


Willie Francis was sentenced to death for murdering the drugstore boss where he was working when he was 16 years old. In 1946, this murderer was put on an electric chair. But due to the problem of the electric system, Willie

Francis did not die and he became the first case of death after being put on the US electronic chair.



The reason is that a prison officer was drunk while checking the operation of the electric chair before using it to execute Willie Francis. A year later, Willie Francis was taken to the court room. In this second time, people checked the electric chair carefully to prevent "incidents" like last time.



Usually, an execution lasts for a maximum of 10 minutes, but Joseph R. Wood, a US death row inmate, has to spend 2 hours of pain before dying of poisoning in 2014.



As soon as the specialists injected sedation and pain relief into the vein, Wood began to breathe. The witnesses present at the execution witnessed the man breathing more than 6,000 times and snoring for almost two hours before he died. Those who oppose the death penalty in the United States consider it a failed execution.
