

The simplest way to create a virtual drive using Virtual Drive

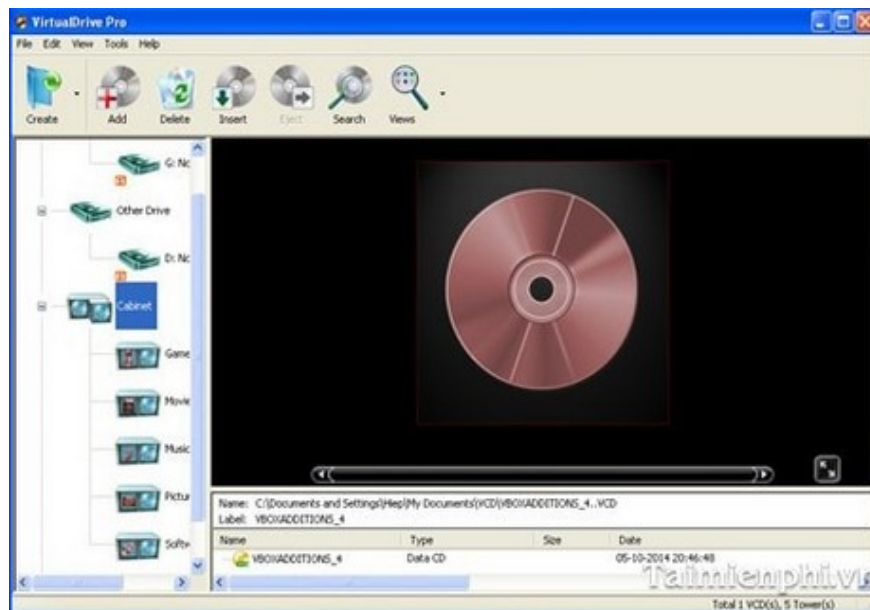
Virtual Drive helps create virtual drives quickly, allowing you to run ISO files without using a physical CD/DVD drive. This tool is good for installing software, games and working with data.

Instructions for creating virtual drives with VirtualDrive Pro

Step 1 : Download and install the software on your computer. **Download Virtual Drive**

Step 2 : After installation is complete, open the program. Program interface after installation is complete.



Step 3 : At the program interface, select **Create**, a new window appears.

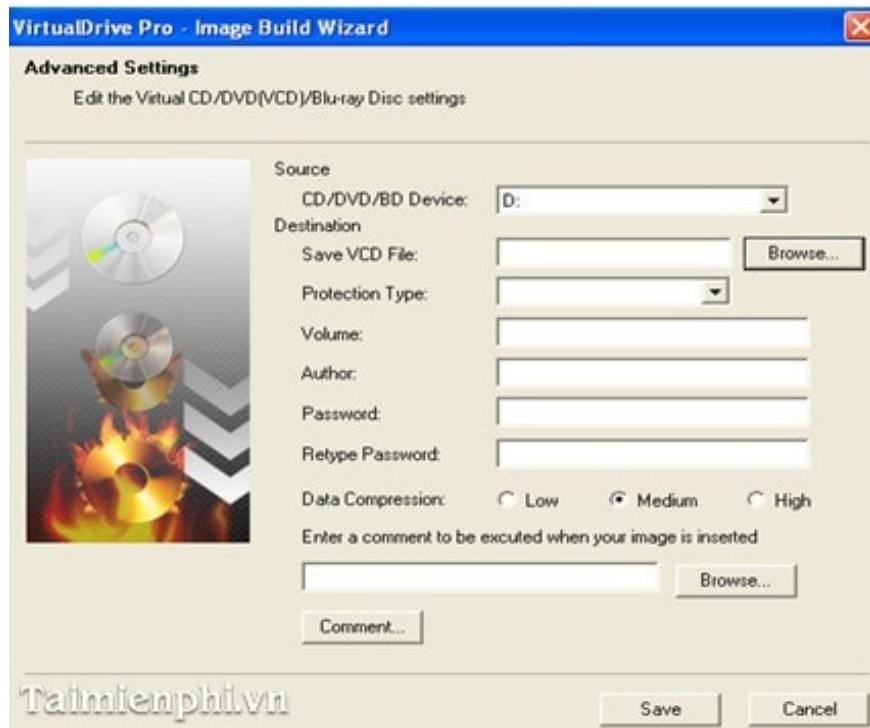


Step 4 : If you want to Create a virtual disc from a real disc, select **Create a Virtual CD from CD/DVD Blu-ray Disc** .

A new window appears with the **VCD label** option : Name the virtual drive, uncheck the **Eject the disk when the build process is complete** item if you do not want the program to automatically eject the disk from the real CD/DVD drive after completing the process.



- Next, go to the **Advanced Settings** option.



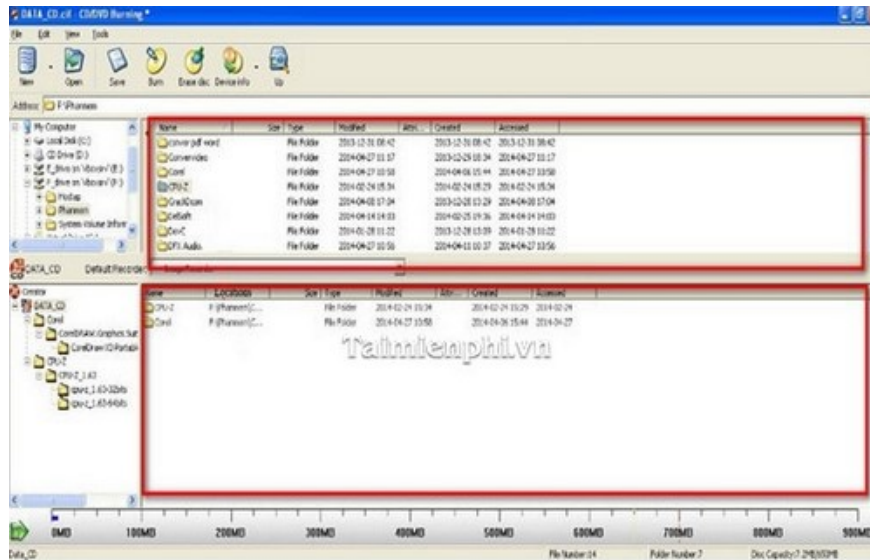
You select the drive you want to create in the **Source** section and lead to the virtual drive storage location in the **Save VCD File** section .

If you want to set a password for the virtual disk, select **Password / Retype Password** .

Options for compression levels and compression capacity in the **Data Compression** section: **The Browse / Comment** option will support automatic execution of files with messages every time a virtual disk is inserted into the optical drive.

Select **Save** then **Start** to let the program perform the task.

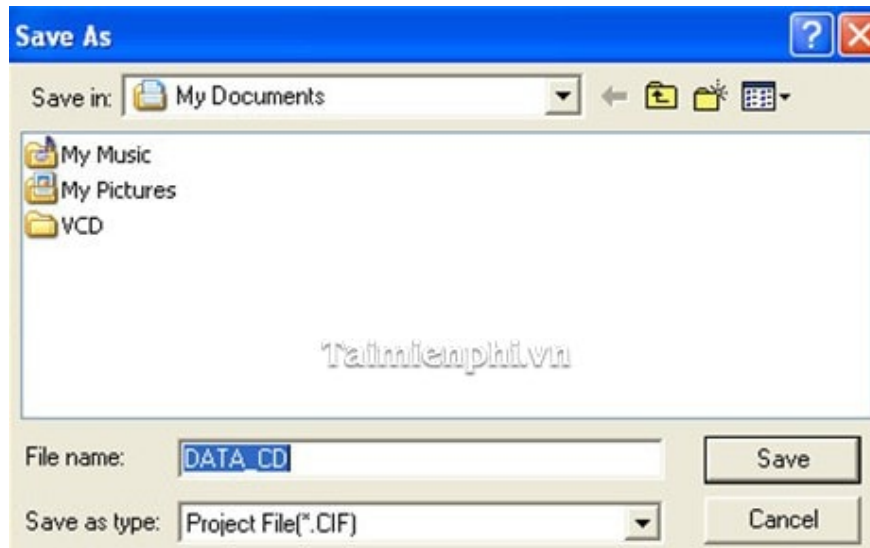
Step 5 : If you want to Create a virtual disk from any folder or file, select **Create a Virtual CD from Files/Foder**



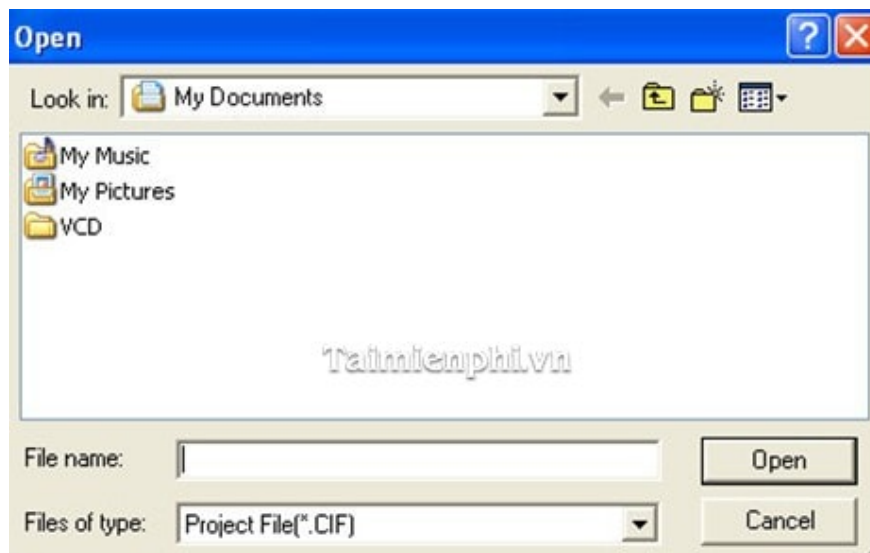
The upper frame is the **name of the data** that needs to be put into the virtual disk; The lower frame is the data storage area. You drag and drop the data that needs to be put into the lower data frame.

OK, When finished, click the **Save button**

Here you name the virtual disk file, choose a storage location, and **Save**.



Step 6 : If you want to create a virtual disk from a project, select **Create a Virtual CD from a Project**.



Select the location where the **Project** is stored and select **Open**. The program will automatically write the **project** to a virtual disk.

Step 7 : Go to My Computer, right-click to open the drive and enjoy.



With Virtual Drive, accessing virtual drives becomes faster and more convenient. This software not only helps create virtual drives on Windows 10 but also supports storing and securing data effectively. If you need an alternative solution, you can refer to software such as UltraISO, PowerISO.
