

The story of the miserable life of Google CEO Sundar Pichai

But after the glamor and resounding successes is a life full of ups and downs of Sundar Pichai that few people know.

Sundar Pichai is not only known as a CEO of a well-known technology company, but he is also known as Silicon Valley's current king of technology.

In 2015, thanks to Google's reform, after a night, Sundar Pichai became one of the world's top CEOs, holding in Google - developing Alphabet's technology.

But after the glamor and resounding successes is a life full of ups and downs of the little known Sundar Pichai.



Coming from a well-off family in Chennai, India, in a family of four, his father was the manager of a famous technology company in India - GEC, and his mother worked as a shorthand for a newspaper and a younger brother. The apartment that Sundar Pichai family lives in is quite small, only 2 rooms: 1 bedroom for parents and 2 Sundar brothers to sleep in the living room. The only valuable asset that the family owns is the TV.

Right from school, the CEO soon proved his ability more than his peers. This is reflected in the fact that he can remember most of his parents' friends, family, and business partners when he was only 12 years old.



In addition to remembering all the contacts, he also showed interest in computers and programming. The opening of Pichai's first achievement was the successful writing of chess games. Later, when going to university, but passionate about technology, Pichai pursued mechanical engineering at the Indian Institute of Technology Kharagpur, thanks to his ability and hard work, Pichai quickly won a scholarship at Stanford, USA.




Moving to California was a big step in the life of Sundar Pichai, especially for a technology lover, and dreamed of growing up in Silicon Valley. Upon arriving in the United States, Pichai was overwhelmed by the largest, most luxurious and expensive country in the world. Everything for him was too expensive, and completely beyond affordability. A simple handbag also costs up to 60 dollars (1.3 million VND equivalent). In the land of his native country, he also often faces the memory of his close friends, and especially his still-in-India girlfriend named Anjali. The latter two were really married and had two children: one boy and one girl.

While studying at Stanford, Pichai also studied electronics that he loved in addition to studying metallurgy. The education policy here allows him to pursue two parallel studies. Soon, Pichai received a medal for outstanding students, and quickly identified his love for electronics and materials.

After that, Pichai received an MBA from Wharton, part of the University of Pennsylvania. He took up a one-year accounting job, until he was interviewed by Google in 2004. The interview took place on April Fool's Day (April 1), the same day Gmail was introduced. Pichai still thinks it's a joke. But it ended up being one of Google's biggest and most successful services, taking steps to knock Yahoo Mail out of their forte.

1. Journey to become Google CEO of Sundar Pichai

After officially working at Google, Pichai quickly proved his ability, and was assigned to the task of Google Toolbar search. Until 2006, Google seemed to have come to the "Apocalypse" when Microsoft decided to make Bing the default search engine on Internet Explorer (IE is still the most popular web browser today). Pichai then tried to convince some computer vendors to install Google's Toolbar software to minimize the losses.

Nest is a company that uses complex technology to solve everyday problems that many people encounter. This is also what CEO Larry Page wants at Google: using complex technology to create a simple solution to solve complex problems that most people encounter.

In addition, Pichai is behind the projects with the Chrome OS operating system platform, also a precursor to Google's Chromebook laptop line. He also demonstrated absolute loyalty to Google, despite being approached by other reputable companies such as Twitter, with higher income and positions.



The success in the field of your forte like Chrome, Chrome OS, software, Android mobile application helps Pichai receive the absolute credibility of Larry Page. He was assigned to manage almost every major area of ?? the company such as search, map, Google+, commerce, advertising, and even the infrastructure and work environment of employees. The fact that Pichai became a Larry Page was not beyond the guesswork of many people, when Larry Page gave up the position of Google CEO to Pichai and took over the parent company Alphabet.
