1. Bhutan

2. Mongolia

Mongolia under Genghis Khan is the largest empire in world history. With an area of 1.565 million km², the 19th largest in the world and a population of 2,839 million (2013), this is the country with the lowest population density on the planet.

3. Switzerland

During the World War, two major opposition Germany-Austria-Hungary and France-Italy surrounded Switzerland from all sides. However, Switzerland is still a neutral country and a refuge for refugees. This country did not have any war from 1815 until now. The Swiss Federal Government has been internationally recognized at the Westphalia Peace Conference, especially at the Wien 1815 Conference, Switzerland committed to pursuing armed and neutral statutes guaranteed by international law. .

4. Madagascar



"We produce vanilla for the world, but nobody cares. Suddenly one day a dancing lion and a zebra appeared funny and now we are famous!"

Vanilla production of Madagascar accounts for about 41% of global vanilla production. But this country is famous all over the world for its Madagascar animated series.

5. Greece

Greece is now sinking in a public debt crisis, causing more than a quarter of the unemployed population.
