

# The terms you need to know when playing Pokémon Go

Pokémon Go is the most prominent name in recent days. This game of capturing and training virtual animals has created a relatively new way of playing, as players have to constantly move to catch Pokémon. During the process of joining Pokémon Go, you will encounter and use a lot of important terms. So what do they mean?

As soon as Pokémon Go greeted the game village around the world, the online community formed a storm that caught Pokémon and spread with tremendous speed. Gamers raced to download games to smartphones and quickly joined the line of participants to catch Pokémon. And everyone wants to confine themselves to many Pokémon warriors, to participate in a battle of balance with other opponents. Therefore, important terms in the game are things that you need to pay attention to. Understanding the terminology will help you become a good catcher of Pokémon.

**Battle** : In the opponent's Gym, you can fight against the opponent's Pokemon team to take over that Gym. Whenever destroying 1 Pokemon in the opponent's team will reduce the reputation and lvl of the gym. Credibility of 0 you will occupy that gym.

**Combat Power (CP)** : The power of each Pokemon, the higher a Pokemon has a CP, the greater its combat ability.





**Defender Bonus** : is the reward received every day when you are protecting a Gym area. Get in the Shop. Rewards include: Poke Coin and Stardust.

**Eggs** : Pokemon eggs can be found in PokeStops, when placing eggs in the incubator and going to the designated area, eggs will hatch into Pokemon.



**Evolution :** **Evolution** is the process of using candy to change a pokemon into the next type of Pokemon.

**Candy :** Candy. Can get candy by catching Pokemon, hatching eggs and transferring Pokemon to professors.

**Experience Points (XP) :** Experience points measure the progress of each coach. Increasing enough XP will achieve a higher level.

**Fainted Pokemon** : A Pokemon fainted when its HP (HP) drops to 0. Pokemon with 0 HP must be revived by items such as Revive or Max Revive.

**Gyms** : is an area where you can fight against rival teams or train your Pokemon. If you have a gym, it is a friendly gym, otherwise, it is an opponent's Gym. Gyms are not owned by anyone called the Open Gym.

**Hit Points (HP)** : The health of a Pokemon is determined by HP. When  $HP = 0$ . Pokemon will faint.

**Incense** : "Drop your hearing" to attract wild Pokemon near your location.

**Incubator** : **Incubator** , used to hatch Pokemon eggs.

**Lure Module** : Use to attract Pokemon about a PokeStops in a certain time period.

**Lucky Egg** : **Lucky** eggs, get twice the amount of XP in the given time.

**Medals** : Rewards every time you complete a game's achievements.

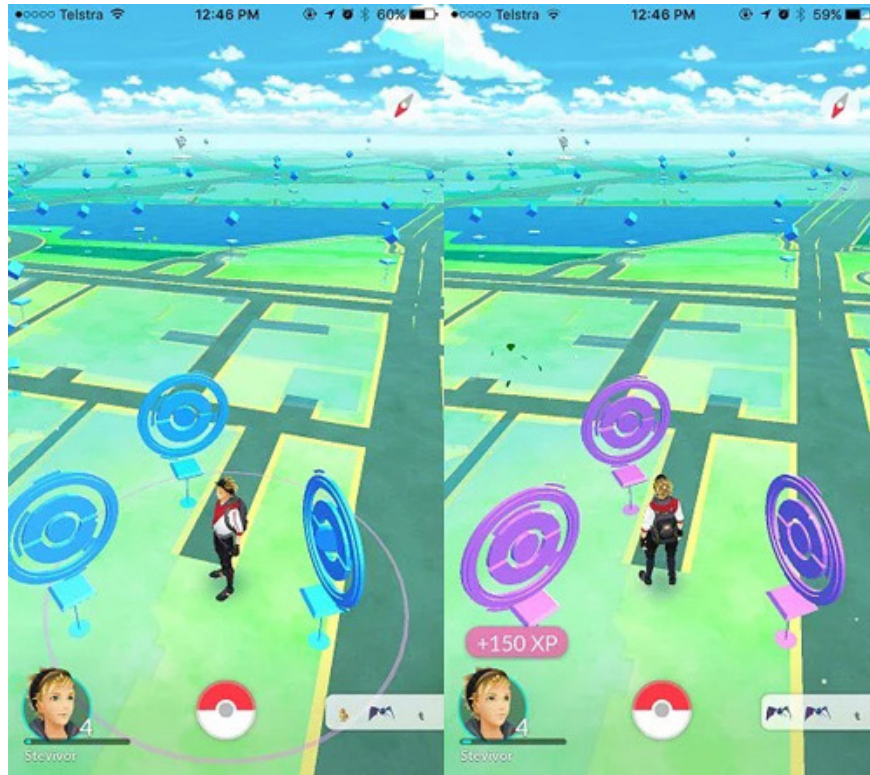
**Pokeballs** : Items to win wild Pokemon in nature. Great Balls, Ultra Balls and Master Balls are higher levels, increasing the ability to catch Pokemon.



**PokeCoins** : World currency Pokemon, can be used to exchange items in the Shop.

**Pokedex** : Encyclopedia of Pokemon types.

**PokeStops** : area you can get support items. Pokestops is usually in areas such as squares, areas with special architecture . When you get close to PokeStops, a green square icon will appear on the screen and you can start receiving items.



**Potion** : there are many Potion types. Use them to restore HP to Pokemon.

**Power Up** : Using Candy and Stardust, coaches can increase the power of Pokemon (HP and CP).

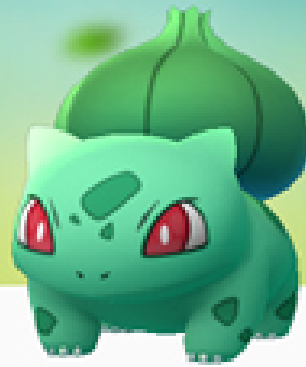
**Prestige** : is a prestigious point of a gym. Obtained by giving Pokemon practice at the gym. Increase Prestige points to level Gyms.

**Razz Berry** : Use to feed wild Pokemon while catching them, making it easier to catch.

**Stardust** : Obtained by catching Pokemon, Hatching an egg or earning a Defender Bonus point. Used to power up Pokemon.
