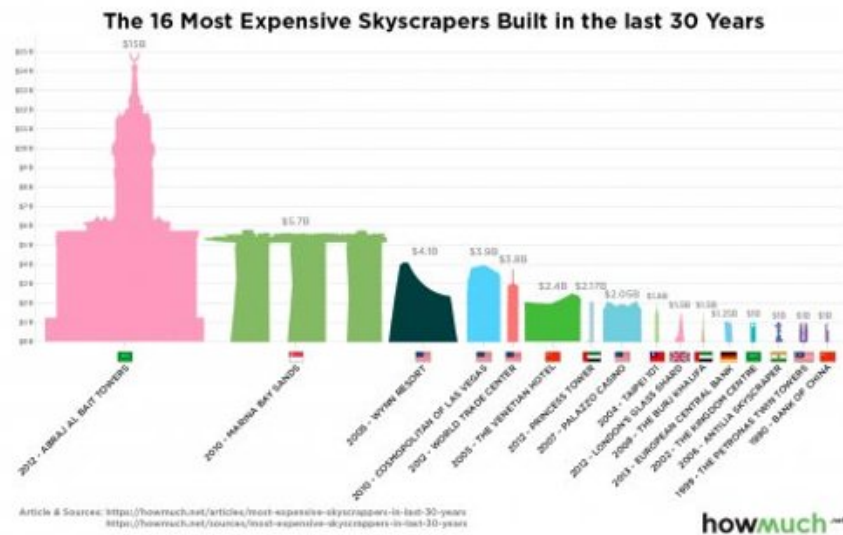

16. Bank of China Building

1. Construction cost: 1 billion USD
2. Location: China

China's national bank building is one of the country's oldest buildings. The construction process was completed in 1990.

15. Petronas Twin Towers

1. Construction cost: 1 billion USD
2. Location: Malaysia

Petronas Twin Towers was completed in 1999 in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. It holds the title of the world's tallest building from 1998-2004 and is still the tallest twin tower today.

14. Antilia Building

2. Location: India

The construction of this Antilia skyscraper was completed in 2006 in Mumbai, India. This individual-owned building has 27 floors and 173m high.

13. Kingdom Center Building

2. Location: Saudi Arabia

Completed in 2002 in Riyadh, **Kingdom Center** is still the tallest building in the country so far. Inside is the Four Seasons hotel and apartments.

12. European Central Bank

1. Construction cost: 1.25 billion USD
2. Location: Germany

European Central Bank was inaugurated in 2013 in the city of Frankfurt, Germany. This is where the central bank determines monetary policy for all members of the European Monetary Union.

11. Burj Khalifa Tower

2. Location: *United Arab Emirates (United Arab Emirates - UAE)*

Burj Khalifa was completed in 2009 in Dubai and is currently the tallest building in the world.

10. London Glass Shard

2. Location: United Kingdom

This London Glass Shard 95-story skyscraper was built in London, England in 2012. It was formerly known as London Bridge Tower or '*Tower of London*'.

9. Taipei 101

2. Location: Taiwan

This building was completed in 2004 in Taipei, Taiwan and was formerly known as the *Taipei World Financial Center* .

8. Palazzo Casino

2. Location: USA

This casino is the highest complex building in Las Vegas, built in the Italian Renaissance style.

7. Princess Tower

1. Construction cost: 2.17 billion USD
2. Location: UAE

This apartment building was built in Dubai and completed in 2012. It is the 24th tallest building in the world.

6. Vanetian hotel

2. Location: China

This is a Casino hotel, built in 2005, in Las Vegas. In addition, it also has a similar hotel with the investor.

5. World Trade Center

Freedom Tower has replaced the previous twin towers. Standing tall in New York City, this is one of the works that represents the face of the United States.

4. Cosmopolitan Hotel

Marina Bay Sand building was completed in 2010 in Singapore. Currently it is a resort business complex, combined with casino.
