This is a trick that *Wayne Williams*, a veteran computer expert, *Betanews* technology has successfully done to continue to update Windows XP until 2019.

The method is very simple. Your job is to create a *.reg file with the following content:

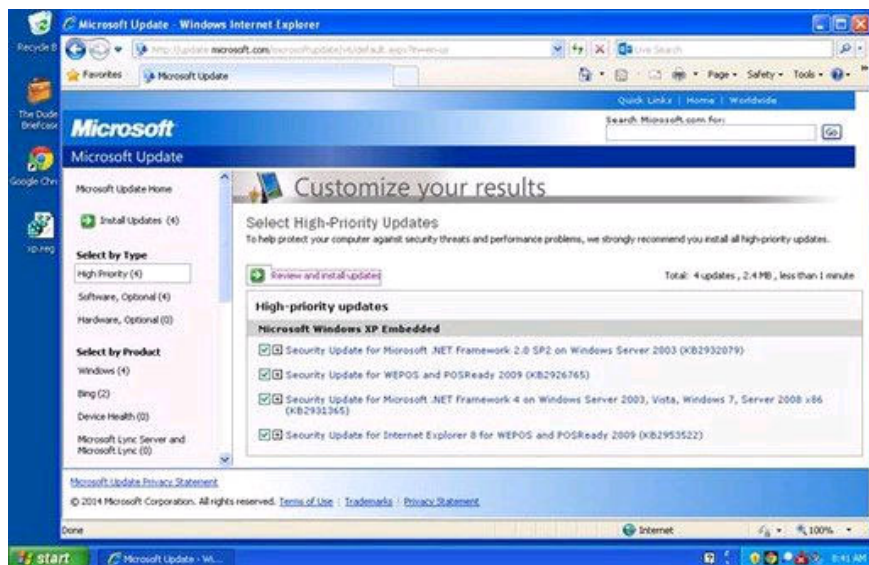
```
[HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\SYSTEM\WPA\PosReady]
```

```
"Installed" = dword: 00000001
```

Or you can download the *.reg file created [here](#) .

After creating this *.reg file, run it, click **Yes** to finish. So you can update the updates for windows XP already.

Note: This method only applies to 32-bit Windows XP.



However, this is only a trick and it is difficult to determine in the future when Microsoft will prevent updating the operating system in this way. So if you use this method unsuccessfully, it means Microsoft has already fixed it.
