The E6430s is the latest laptop model for Dell Latitude business people in Vietnam market. This product "ignores" the trend of ultra-thin era like ultrabook but instead is quite thick design. However, compared to its appearance, the E6430s feels very light, weighing 1.7 kg for a 14-inch screen that can be considered excellent. The maximum thickness is about 30.9 mm, making the space inside the machine more airy and heat dissipation better than the thin and light models.

The Latitude E6430s has the entire chassis made of sturdy magnesium alloy, which is surrounded by a scratched aluminum cover and fingerprint-resistant coating. According to the manufacturer, this structure of the machine can withstand light shock or shock to protect the hard drive as well as other internal components better. The appearance of the product can be considered a bit "rough" compared to a common user but is a reasonable choice for entrepreneurs.

Another noteworthy feature in the E6430s is that the screen border is quite thin, thanks to this, despite being 14 inches in size, the entire product size is only equivalent to a regular 13-inch screen laptop.

The configuration of the E6430s is also good compared to the needs of business users. Without the option of discrete graphics card, but the machine has an Intel Core i5-3320M processor with 2.6 GHz speed which belongs to the latest Ivy Bridge platform and Intel HD Graphics 4000 graphics chip (40% better graphics capabilities) with the previous generation).

The latest connections have also been added to this product such as USB 3.0 ports, eSATA (rarely seen on mainstream laptops this year), HDMI, the standard 34mm ExpressCard expansion card slot, and SmartCard card reader slots. The keyboard of the machine is traditionally designed, instead of the recent chiclet form and has more backlighting. As a business model, the E6430s also has a joystick in the center of the keyboard to control the mouse and comes with four mouse buttons above and below the touchpad. This is a layout that resembles the ThinkPad line and is typical for business people.

In addition, it also has the indispensable security features and technologies such as Trusted Platform Module (TPM), Intel vPro, Dell Data Protection, Access and Dell Data Protection, Encryption2.
