

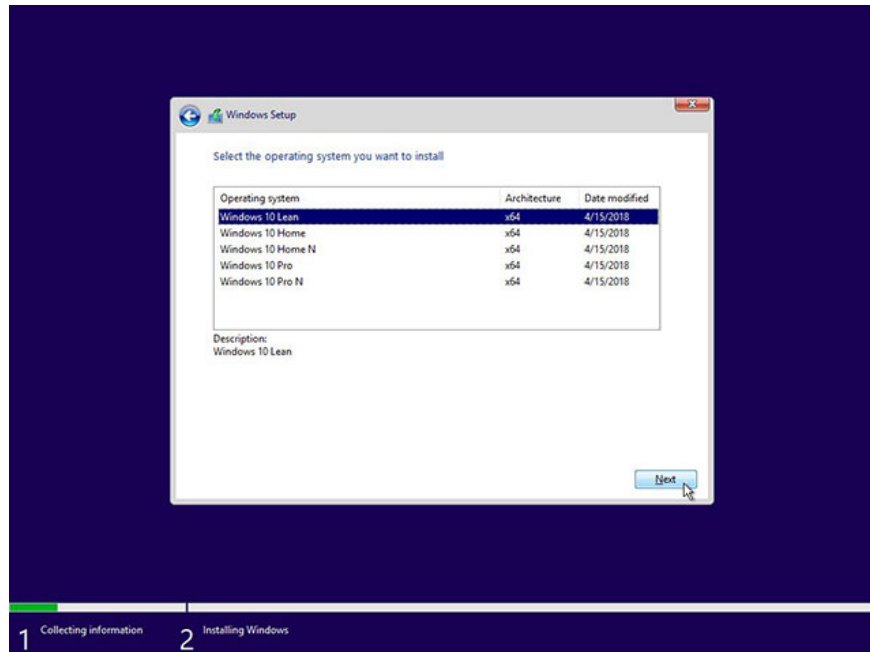
The upcoming Windows 10 update will have a lean version for low memory devices

Windows Central said that this version will be available on 16GB devices and mainly to make sure these machines receive Windows updates.

Microsoft is gradually reducing the amount of storage needed by removing unnecessary elements on low-end devices, such as Internet Explorer or other old applications.
