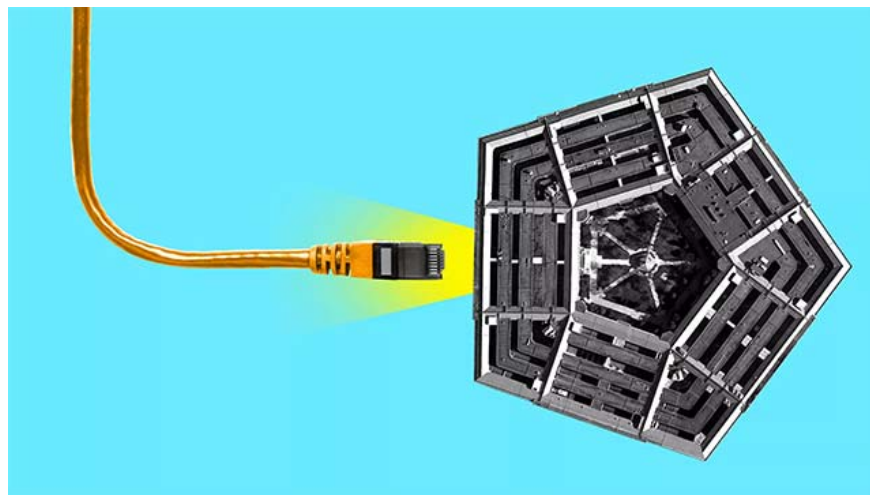


# The US \$ 10 billion contract between the Pentagon and Amazon threatens to collapse due to issues related to data processing.

The Pentagon has recently decided to suspend the deployment of a \$ 10 billion cloud contract until the US Department of Defense completes the necessary inspection procedures.

The Pentagon has recently decided to halt the deployment of a \$ 10 billion cloud contract until the US Department of Defense completes the necessary testing procedures to determine whether the whether this data will work in favor of Amazon and leave open the fate of this huge contract. A Pentagon spokesman said in a press release on Thursday that 1/8 of the Pentagon will keep its promises to members of Congress and the American public about a thorough review. Joint Enterprise Defense Infrastructure (JEDI) program has a strategic meaning to US security. Plans related to the inspection will be directed and supervised directly by defense minister Mark Esper. 'There will be no decisions about the program given at least until the inspection process is completed,' said the Pentagon representative.

The Pentagon and Amazon's \$ 10 billion cloud contract is an important part of the JEDI implementation plan. If expected, the contract will most likely be signed this month. However, with the decision from the US defense agency, the fate of the contract will be a big question mark.

Previously, the bidding process of this huge cloud computing project has also caused great controversy in public opinion over the past few months. Full participation of the big players in the field of cloud computing at the stage of submitting bids, including Oracle, Microsoft, Amazon, IBM and Google. After a short time of receiving documents, Google was the first name to give up due to the overwhelming pressure from employees as well as internal corporate board conflicts over the issue of 'morality' if the Mountain giant View involved in the project to provide its technology to the military for the purpose of war. After a series of consecutive strikes broke out for several days, Sundar Pichai CEO had to withdraw from the bidding package and send letters to employees to ease the situation.

For a while after the decision to withdraw from Google, Amazon became the company that won the contract and immediately planned to prepare. However, the storm continued to return to the JEDI project and tensions reached a peak at the end of the month before President Donald Trump said that Amazon was involved in a tacit plot to win a contract agreement, At the same time, Jeff Bezos and his team will create a "long-term monopoly plan" that could negatively affect national interests.

Trump's allegations are said to be similar to those of Oracle's executive vice president, Ken Glameck, who is responsible for the company's lobbying campaign.

Earlier, Oracle also raised similar concerns in a December lawsuit against the US Department of Defense, claiming that the Pentagon's requirements for contracts were created in a way that was more profitable for Amazon. , making this e-commerce giant and cloud computing easy to out-compete other big players that have the same potential as Microsoft, Amazon, IBM, and won the lucrative bid worth 10 billion USD.

Legislators on Capitol Hill have been involved in the controversy in recent weeks, with the latest move being to send a letter to the president, asking the White House head to put pressure on delaying the decision. the contract until the relevant authorities complete the re-inspection of the whole project as well as the bidding process.

However, there are also many concerns that prolonged disputes may negatively affect JEDI, even causing this plan to completely collapse.

'This contract has been delayed for more than a year to serve investigations and receiving court records. Further delays will negatively affect the Ministry of Defense. It makes the Pentagon lag behind because we need this technology right now. Cloud technologies will turn the military into a more efficient, more dangerous, agile and creative force, 'a Republican Senator said.

In a letter sent and signed by 12 important members of the House of Representatives with support for the continuation of the contract submitted to the US Congress on the day the defense minister Mark Esper assume the role of monitoring the test.
