

The US can eliminate Net Neutrality, and this will completely change the way you use the internet so far

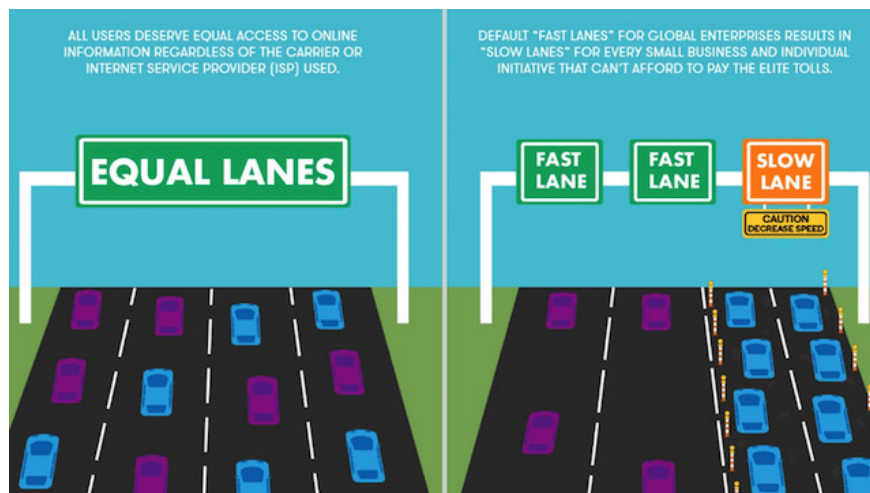
If net neutrality is removed, the US will be the starting point to open a very different future for the Internet.

This week, the US Federal Communications Commission (FCC) will vote to abolish the laws on net neutrality (roughly translated as "internet equality") that was launched in 2015. With people Republican - net neutrality seekers - are taking advantage of the number, almost the result of the upcoming December 14 vote was decided in advance. This also means that the actions against the net neutrality abolition of the online community will become meaningless.

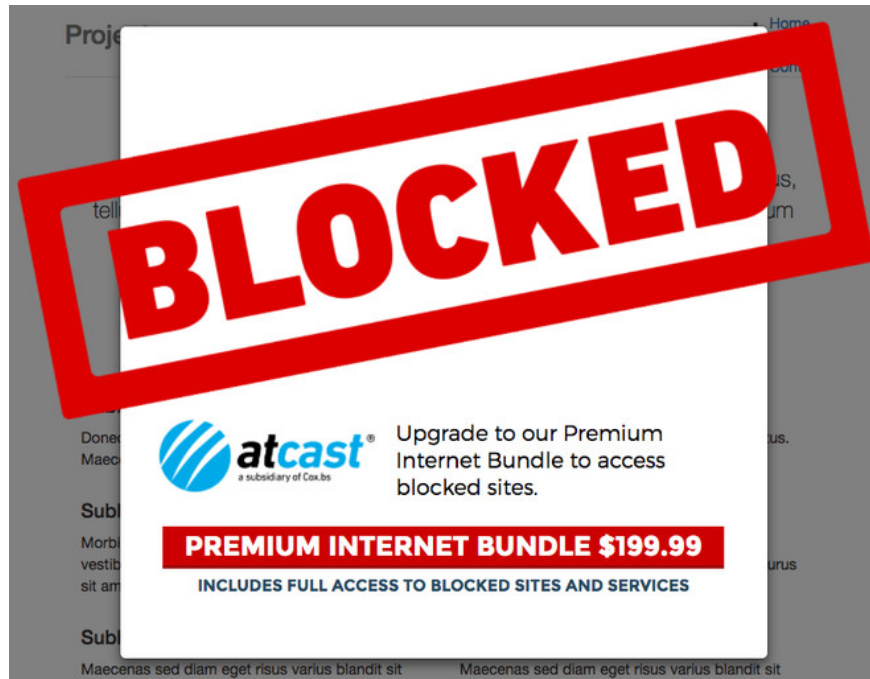
With the loss of net neutrality, the internet will almost completely change, when the big guys in the telecommunications industry will have full control over everything you can do on the internet. The earliest and most heavily influenced will be the people in the US, after that, the influence can spread to the whole world.

What is Net neutrality, and why do big telecom men want to get rid of it so much?

Net neutrality is a principle on the internet, that network service providers need to treat all transmitted packets as equal, regardless of whether it is an email, an emoji sent via Facebook, is a paragraph Video stream is done in a gamer's private room, or a movie on Netflix. To make it easier to imagine, imagine our packets as cars taking traffic, and the internet is a regular road system. So when participating in internet traffic, these cars have the same right to move.

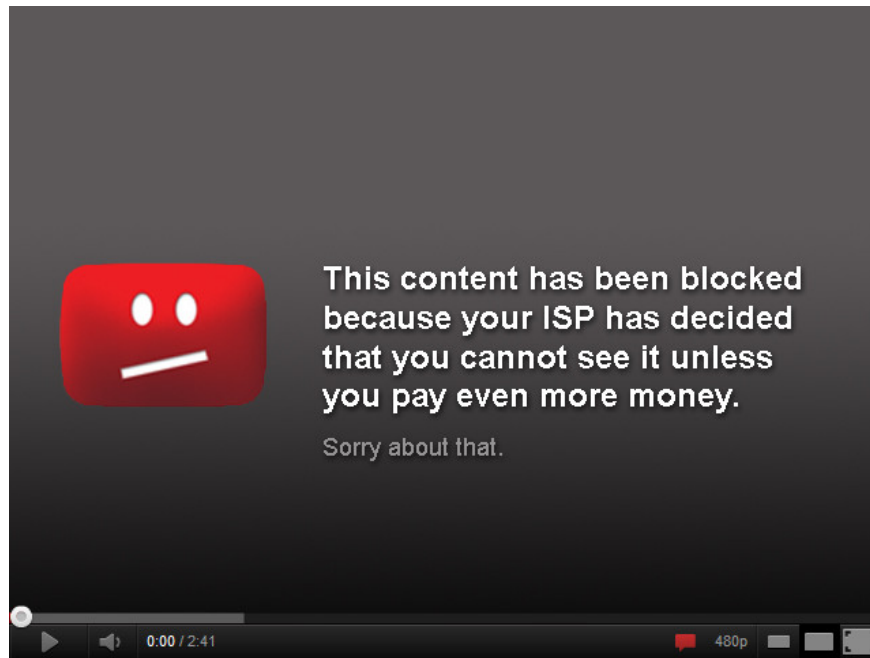


Basically, the law of net neutrality was launched in 2015 by the FCC, prohibiting all blocking, squeezing bandwidth of any service or website on the internet. And this has become a thorn in the eyes of network service providers, especially when operators are now owning their own content production companies. In the US, Comcast owns NBC, AT&T is trying to buy Time Warner, or Verizon owns AOL and Yahoo. If you do not remove the net neutrality, these big men will be forced to compete very hard in terms of content in order to have income from their services, in the context of the war on content on the Internet is an extremely fierce battle.



If net neutrality is removed, telecoms giants will be able to give priority to their "children", and squeeze other competitors. In the above visualization, when there is no net neutrality, the cars owned by the network service provider will go along with a wide road, while other cars will be sent to the road, tiny at the side, with many toll booths located along the road.

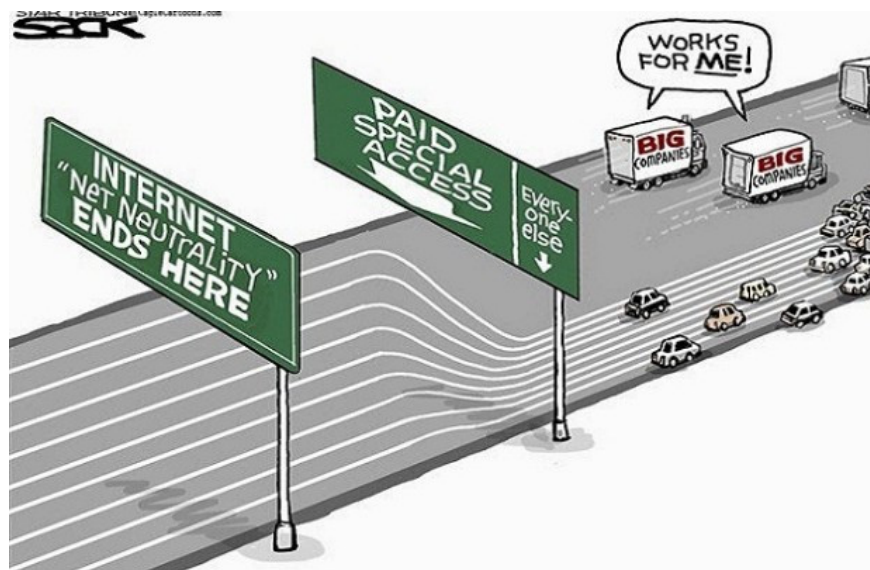
Of course, if so, the people who suffer the most damage are those who use the Internet. Suppose if you use Comcast's network, you will have to pay more to watch videos from Netflix or Amazon, instead of NBC or Hulu owned by Comcast. If you use Verizon's network, you can only use Yahoo! mail, and pay if you want to use Gmail.



And that's just one of many ways for big carriers to get rich from net neutrality abolition. In fact, revenue from users is only a very small fraction, compared to other carriers' revenues: it is "squeezing" competitors.

What if, in the future, Verizon blocked all Google services, and what if Google wanted to bring YouTube to Verizon users? Simple, pay an annual fee here, and Youtube will be included in the "paid service" list for Verizon network users.

Of course, for big guys like Netflix, Amazon or Google, this fee is not worth it. But for technology startups who want to start a business by creating a new service platform, net neutrality abolition also means killing their development path.



When big carriers can be assured of revenue by squeezing other competitors, they will no longer care about improving customer service quality or service quality. in general. It will no longer matter, if their customers have no other options.

And the US will be the starting point to open a very different future for the Internet, if the net neutrality is removed.
