According to The New York Times, the number of deaths due to the new strain of corona virus has reached 300. Patients are dying more and more, but Italy has banned the funeral to prevent the disease from spreading.

David Berendes, an epidemiologist in collaboration with the CDC, suggested: '*If you can livestream the funeral and show it to your family members, we agree to support it .*' For those who face force majeure, cannot go, the

expert Berendes advises to prepare hand sanitizer; Besides, the funeral organizers should relax a little bit, don't let many families meet at the same time.

The CDC also provided additional advice to people present at the funeral, saying that direct contact with the bodies of people infected or suspected to be infected with SARS-CoV-2 virus should be restricted. If this is an indispensable part of a long tradition, then they should consult a funeral expert or organization, find ways to minimize exposure, use gloves and a mask. disposable.
