US scientists find ways to remove passwords

The US Army *Advanced Defense Research Agency* (*DARPA*), responsible for setting up the Internet, is being funded for research projects so that computers will no longer be used. password again.

In a project called " *Active Authentication Project* ", scientists are aiming to use some of the hidden signs that are specific to each and every person that cannot be repeated.

For example, the way we handle our smartphones, the movement of our hands and the movements when we use the phone, can be identified by sensors. The phone can " *remember* " those signs, actively monitor and automatically lock when someone else tries to use the phone.

Other groups of scientists are finding ways to make our computers and smartphones how to recognize the way we write, the words we use, how we structure sentences and the errors we often make Acquired.

There is still another type of security that will ask users to say a phrase instead of typing a password, to perceive not only words but also subtle differences in speech and pronunciation.

DARPA said these projects have produced very good results and some of the largest computer and smartphone manufacturers have expressed interest in assembling them into new devices.
