

The way Facebook checks out is revealed in the September 2018 hack

Does your personal Facebook belong to the 50 million Facebook accounts that were attacked last September?

Last September, more than 50 million Facebook accounts were leaked, causing a stir in the online community worldwide. Facebook has long been the focus of many hackers and cyber attacks. So how to know if Facebook account has been attacked in the 50 million Facebook accounts that leaked? The following article will show you how to check whether personal Facebook data is safe or not.

Instructions for checking your Facebook account

First, log into your Facebook account as usual. Next visit the link below to check your personal Facebook account.

In this interface will display information about the Facebook attack last September. We scroll down if we see **the green frame and the message** as shown below, which means your Facebook account is not hacked.

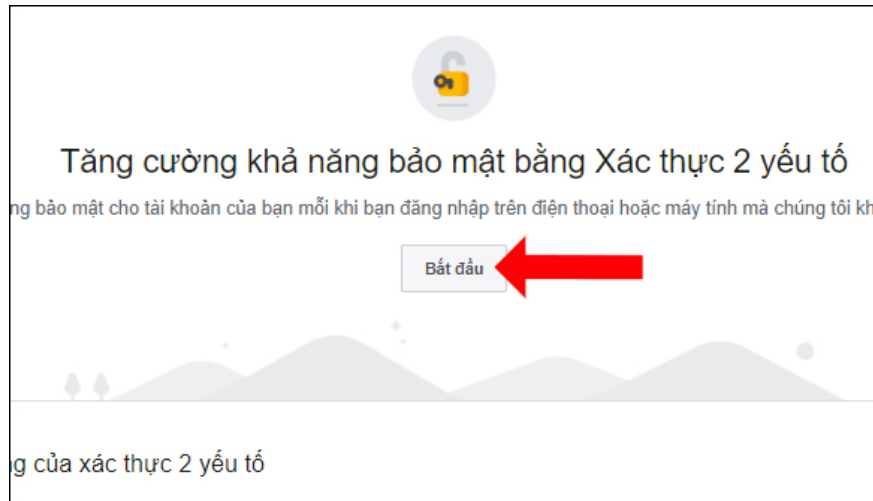

Is my Facebook account impacted by this security issue?

Based on what we've learned so far, your Facebook account has not been impacted by this security incident. If we find more Facebook accounts were impacted, we will reset their access tokens and notify those accounts.

If your Facebook account is in the attack, it will receive the earliest notification from Facebook. However, before the attack leaked this information, users should change the Facebook account password. It is possible to implement some Facebook security methods such as Facebook login through 2 classes, Facebook information lock, .



In case the user sees suspicious signs like anyone using his Facebook, quickly exit the remote Facebook account to log out of the Facebook account on the device in use. If necessary, permanently delete your Facebook account. But users need to be sure they want to delete Facebook and need to do things before deleting Facebook like downloading Facebook data, making sure to contact friends, .
