Method 1: Use the inferred stamp patterns

This method is only used when you fold, this is not the most effective way because it depends a lot on the arrow signs you have. Simply this way, you will copy these arrows and paste them into your article.

Sign inferred: ??

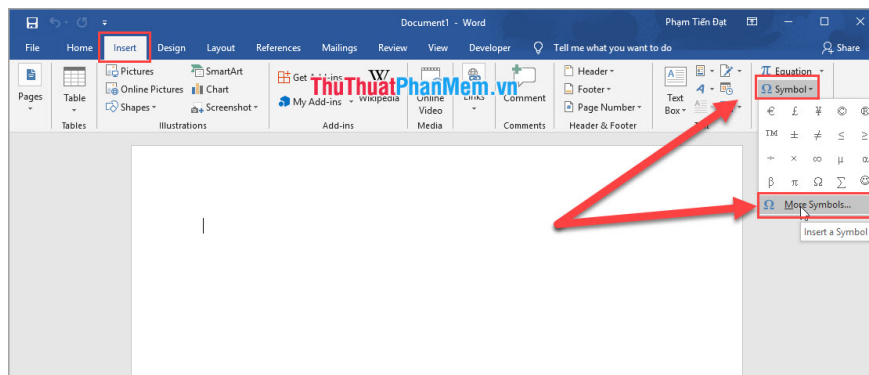

Method 2: Use the special character set of Symbol

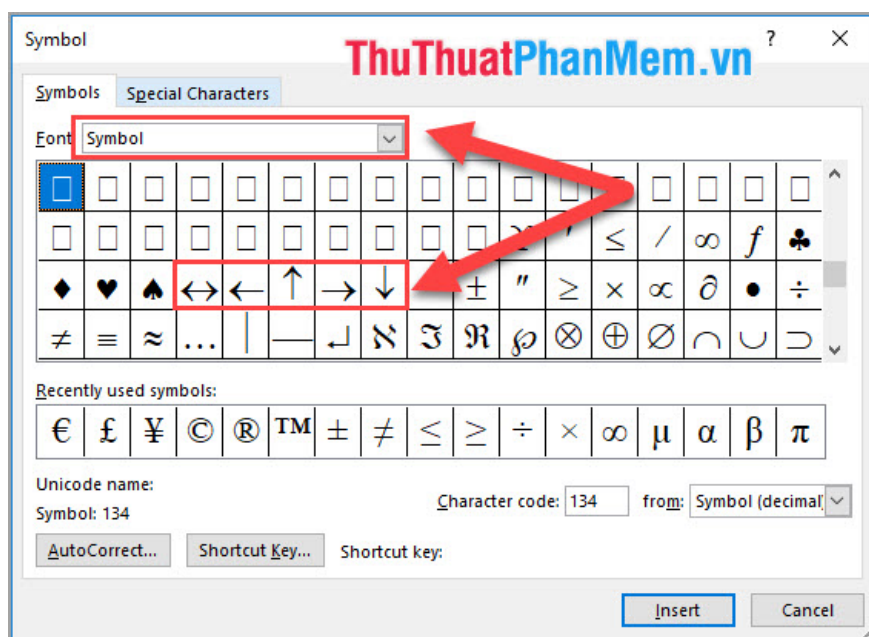
This is one of the best, most amazing and most diverse ways. This way you can create many different types of arrows to your liking.

Step 1: You select the **Insert** tab and select **Symbol -> More Symbols**.

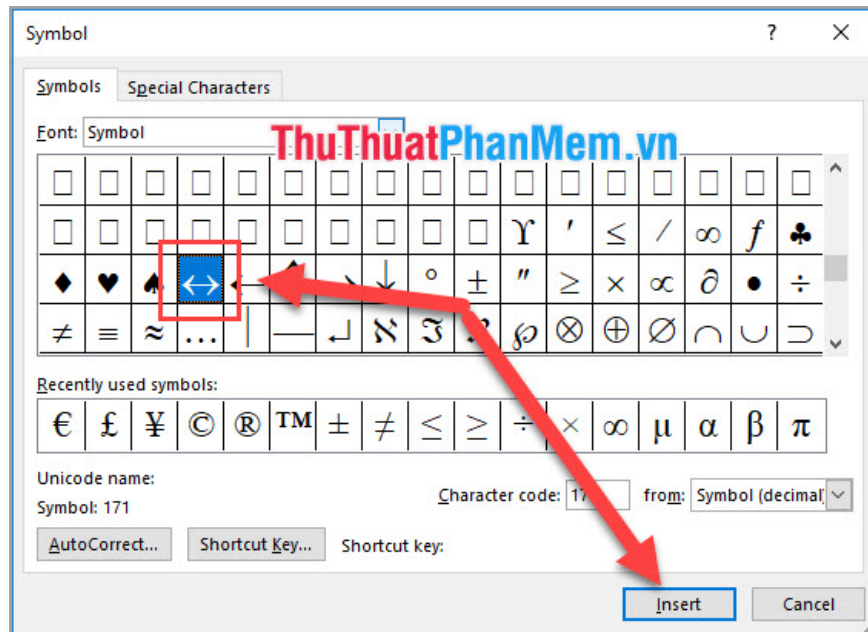


Step 2: At this time, the **Symbol** window will appear. Here you should note:

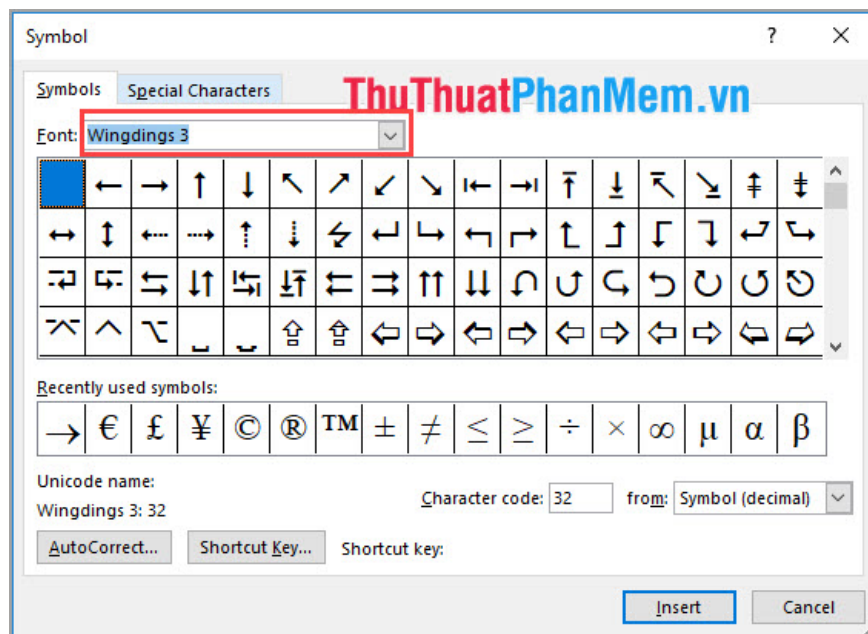
Section **Font** you choose **Symbol** to have the most arrows and most beautiful.



Step 3: Click on the arrow you want and select **Insert** to add in the article.



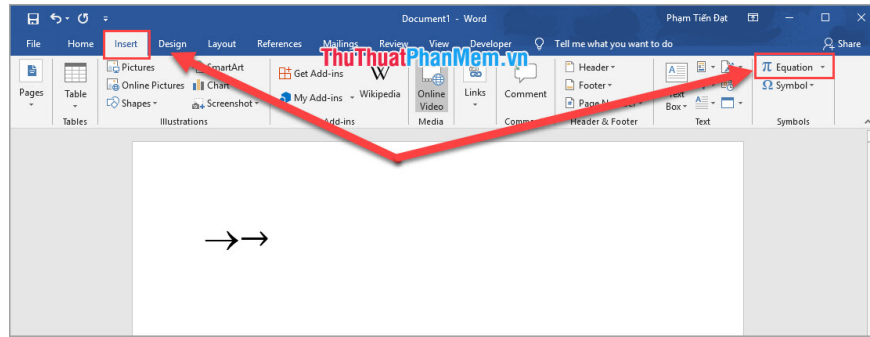
In addition, you can choose **Wingdings 3**, this is a font with lots of different arrow sign characters and very diverse.



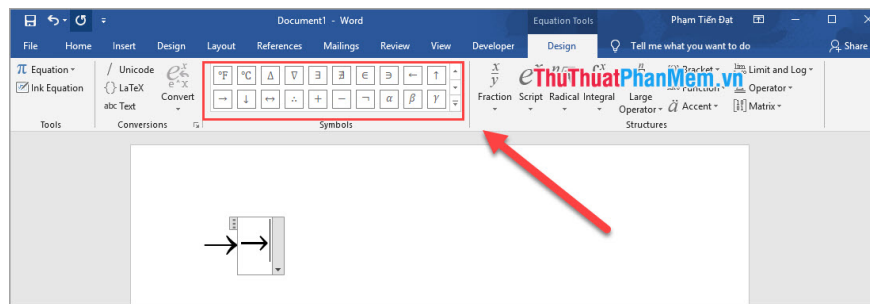
Method 3: Use Equation

This is also a Symbol-like toolkit but has more math-related characters. How to do the same with the same as Symbol.

Step 1: You proceed to select the **Insert** tab and select **Equation** .

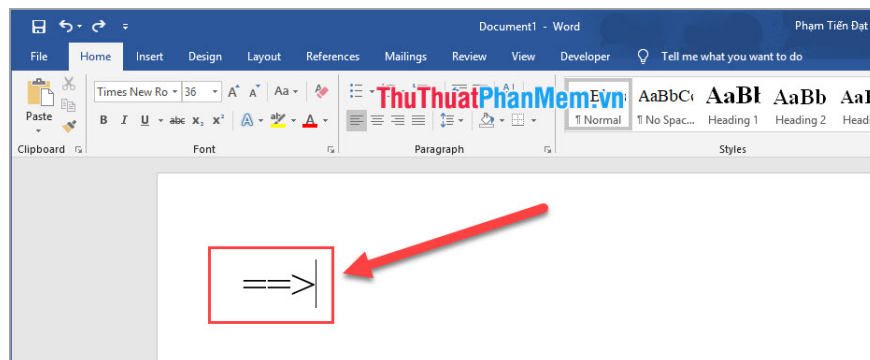


Step 2: At this time, there will be more toolbox writing arrow. Click on the arrow you need, it will automatically appear on the writing page.

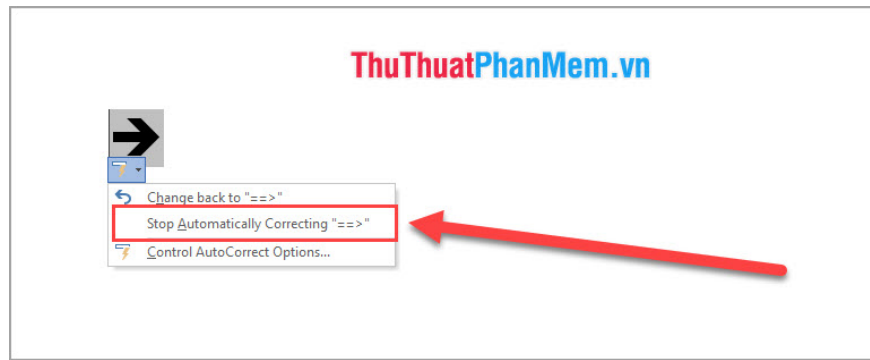


Method 4: Mark out automatically in Word

This is a smart feature and quite convenient to the user. It will help you save a lot of time to use. When you type ==> , the system will automatically recognize the inferred sign and change it to ?



And here is the result when exchanging. If you find this to be an annoying feature, click the arrow and select **Stop Automatically Correcting** so that the software does not change itself into an arrow.
