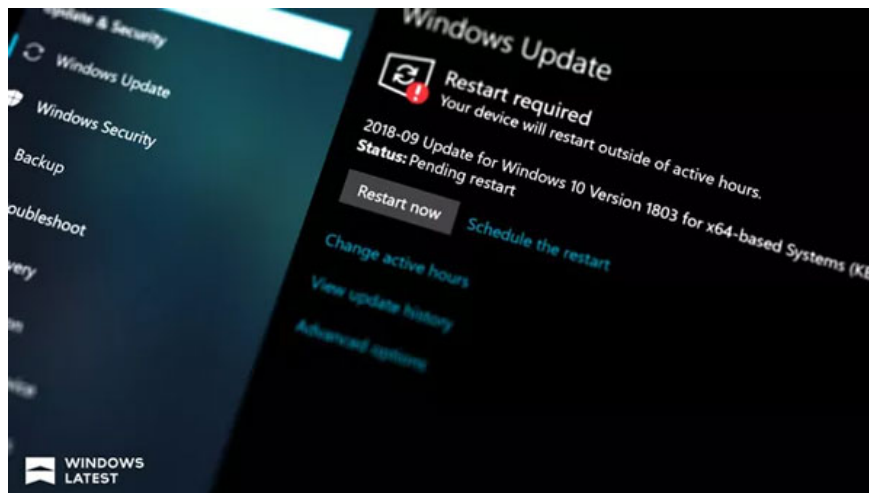


# The Windows 10 KB4532693 update fails, causing a user's file to be deleted
