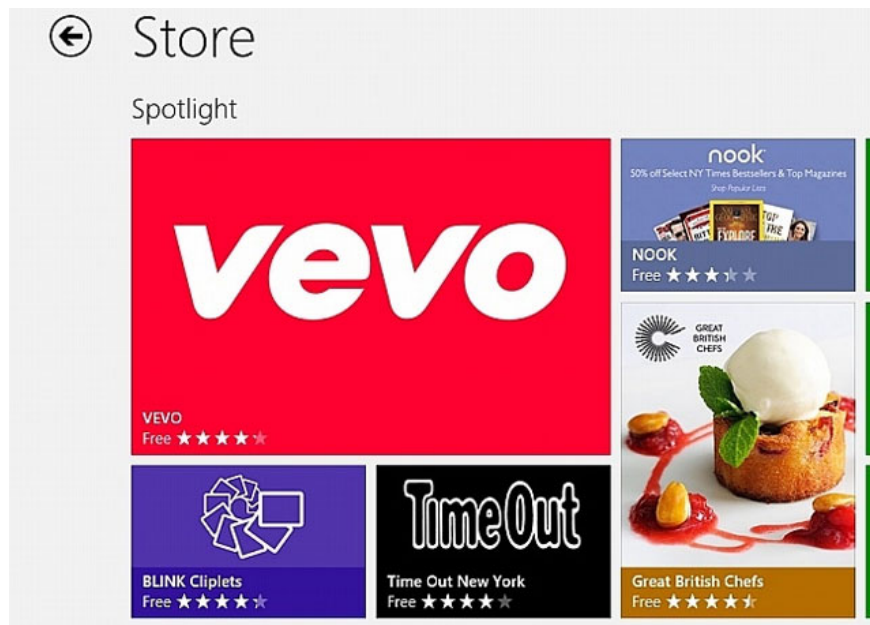


The Windows Store reached a milestone of 100,000 applications

In the **Windows 8.1** update, the Windows Store also has a redesign of the user interface; Improved functionality such as allowing the automatic update application to be updated, allowing automatic shutdown of application updates .
