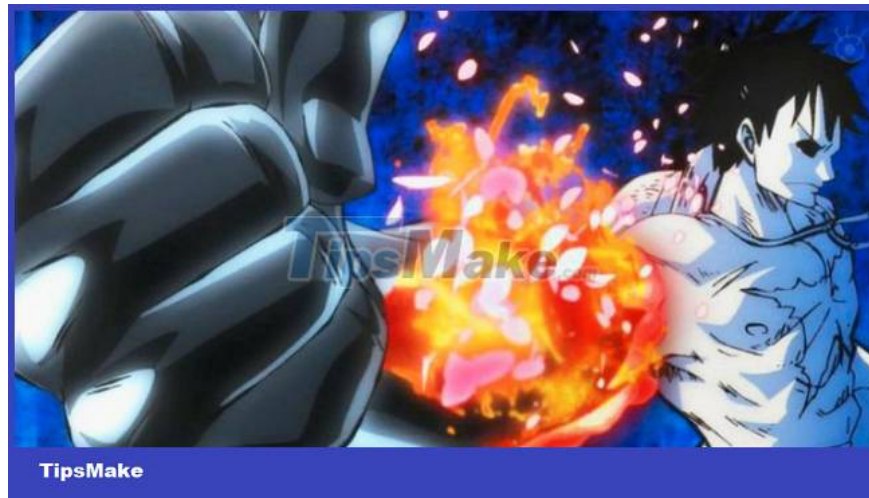


The world of One Piece may have a 4th type of haki

In the One Piece world, characters gain unparalleled strength not only thanks to the devil fruit, but also thanks to another ability added by Oda, which is haki.

Haki is a term that is described as helping to increase the combat aspects of the characters. As we all know, there are currently 3 types of haki: observational, armed, and the rarest is conquest haki.

And after what happened at the last Wano arc, there are many sources that the author will add another type of haki to the series. This new type of haki will be called elemental haki. So what is this hypothesis? Let's also find out meGame.



Throughout the One Piece series, fans have seen many characters create different types of elements but do not need to own any Logia Devil Fruit. That raised a suspicion that Oda would again do what he always did best. That is to use the details to give fans an extremely unexpected "turn of the car".

This theory holds that elemental haki allows the user to control the elements available in nature. For example, the Mink race can control thunder, or the flames created by a person possessing the Zoan fruit, King, .



The most typical examples of elemental haki are members of the revolutionary army. The first is the Koala. Not only does she master mermaid Karate, but she can also create water attacks similar to Jinbe. Next up is Sabo. Before Sabo possessed Ace's Devil Fruit, Sabo had a skill known as "dragon's breath". Sabo punched the ground and gathered his haki to find the core of the ground below, then pumped a blast of air in which resulted in a vortex of destructive power. And of course the revolutionary leader Monkey D. Dragon. Fans have seen wind and storm many times every time he appeared.



Is it possible that the revolutionaries learned about this type of haki and trained it for all members of the organization. We saw after the time-skip, Sanji while being trained by Ivankov, a senior member of the revolutionary army. He has learned two more techniques that are "Sky Walk" in the air and "Blue Walk" in the water. Not only that, but Sanji's feet were surrounded by no longer an ordinary flame, but a blue flame, which was said to be hotter than Akainu's lava. Is this the advanced form of fire elemental haki?



There are many examples of manipulating natural elements without the help of Logia fruit throughout the journey of One Piece such as Brook controlling ice, McGuy controlling thunder,. So the hypothesis about this type of haki is being trusted by the One Piece fan community as the next step of "holy" Oda. MeFans, let meGame hear your thoughts.
