To get this conclusion, Nataniel Lester-Sb and his team conducted an analysis of online medical records of prostate cancer patients and possible risks of illness.

The results showed that the use of hormone therapy in the body of prostate cancer patients has the ability to improve health and quality of life (for patients without pre-existing heart disease).

However, it is worrisome for patients with prehistoric heart disease to use this hormone therapy to have more **heart attacks** .
