1. **Step 2** : The phone will now issue a notification to let everyone know that the call is being recorded.

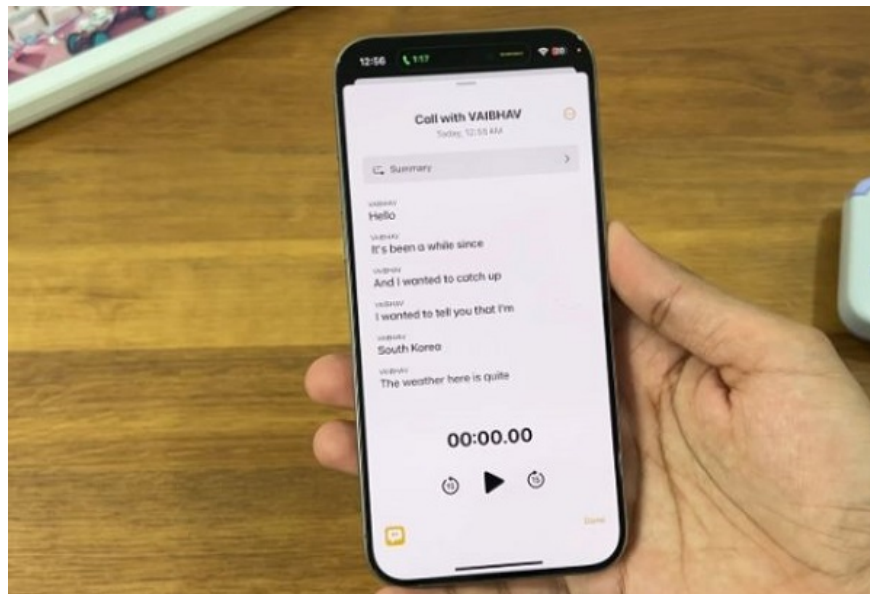
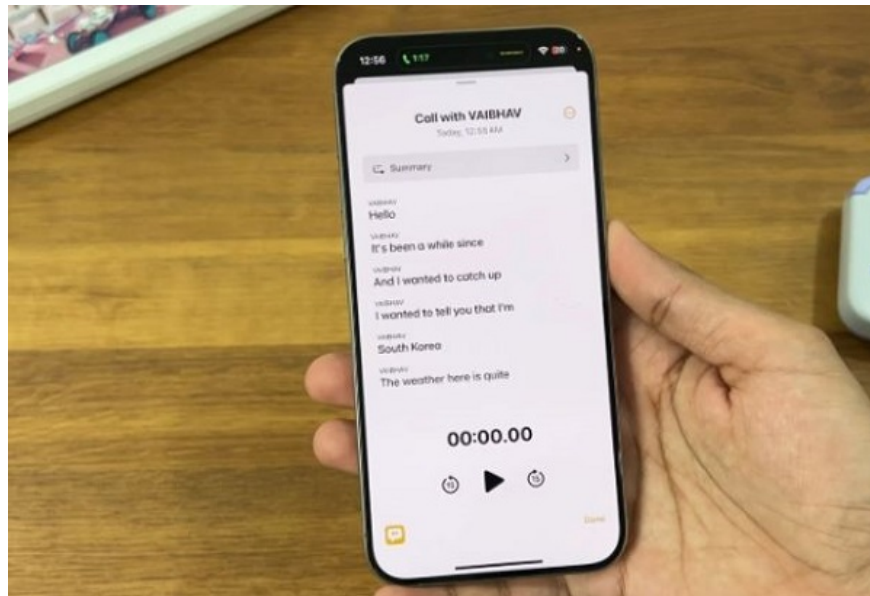




1. **Step 3** : After the call ends, the call recording will be saved to the notes application. Of course, you can come here to listen to the recording again at any time.
